### What's infusion therapy?

Infusion therapy is a method of delivering medications, fluids or nutrients directly into a patient's bloodstream through a vein. It's typically used when a condition is too complex or advanced to be treated with oral medications alone.



#### Site of care cost comparison

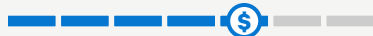

**Many rare disease treatments require infusion therapy due to the specialized nature of the drugs involved.** While it's often provided in hospitals, it can also take place in outpatient clinics, physicians' offices and even patient homes, depending on the situation and level of care needed.

### The hidden cost of chronic illness

Infusion therapy can be life-changing for employees facing complex or chronic conditions like cancer, autoimmune disorders, gastrointestinal diseases and neurological conditions. But it can come at a steep cost. Over the past decade, the number of infusion-administered drugs has increased significantly—from 24 to over 250—and more than 1,400 new therapies are currently in development, according to the FDA. As this option grows, so does the cost exposure for employers. Often, the most significant cost driver is where the infusion care is administered.

### How the program works

Symetra's Infusion Solution program helps clients **spend smarter, without sacrificing care**, by bringing together:



Policyholders will work directly with Quantify Specialty Care (QSC) to offer the program to covered members under the plan. To maximize the program's value, Symetra will apply our proprietary Savings Share Plus Endorsement.

**For example**, when infusion care savings are realized on individual Specific claims that exceed two times the deductible, **Symetra will reimburse the policyholder 15% of those savings—up to a maximum of \$75K**, per covered person per policy period.
