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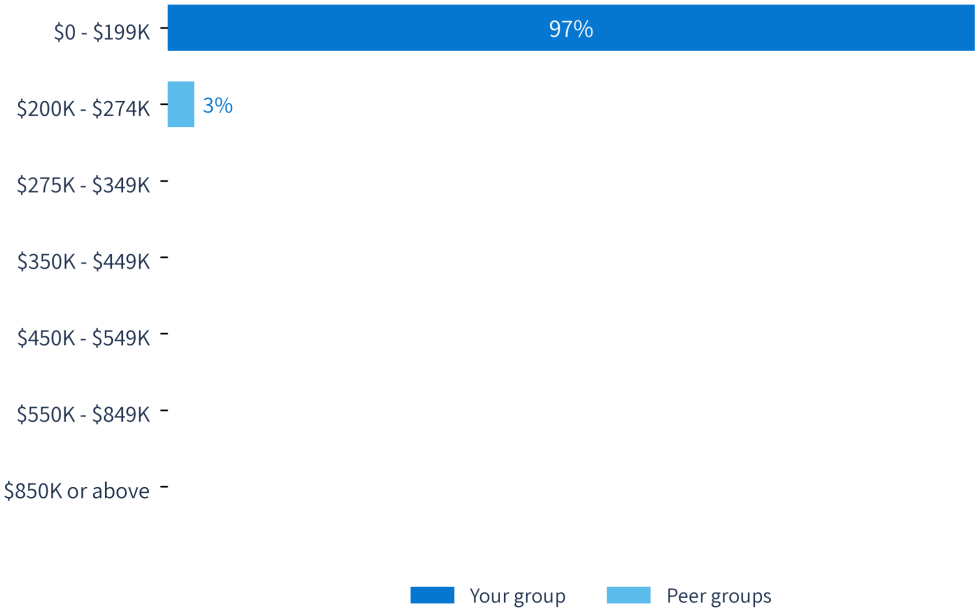

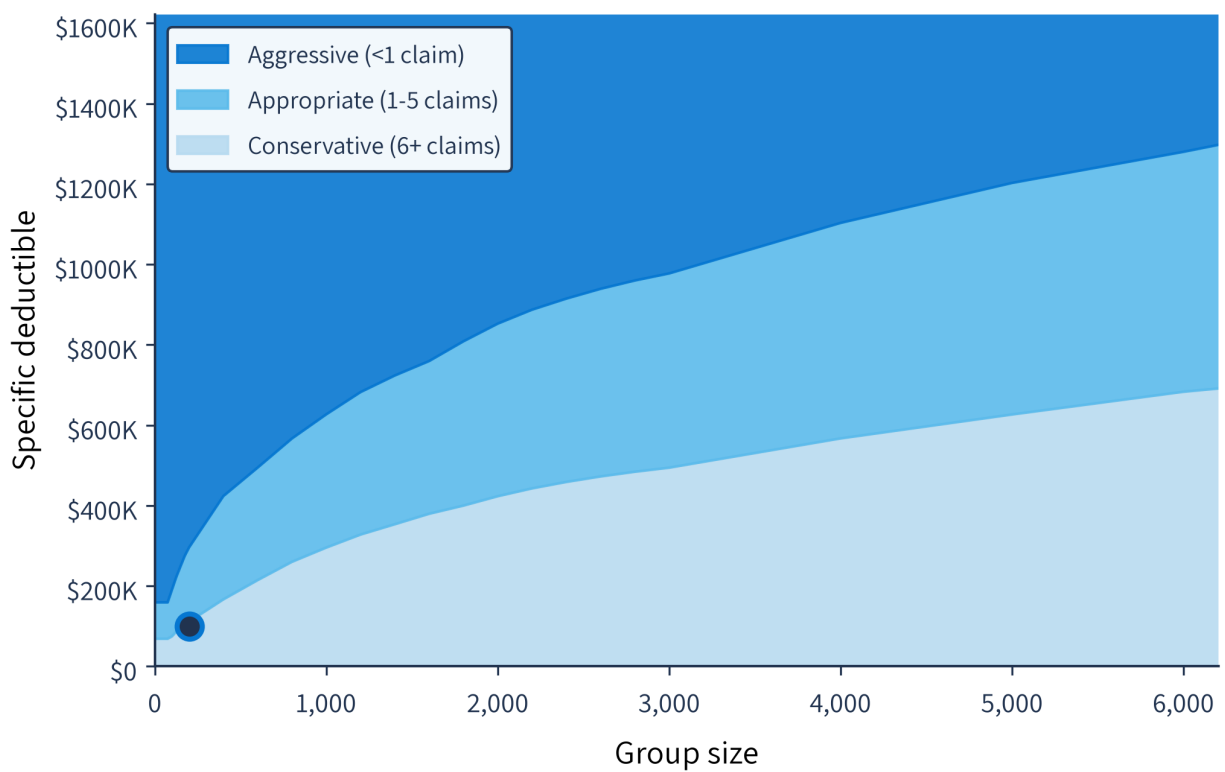
Where are peer companies setting their deductibles?

Shows optimal deductible ranges based on expected claim frequency by group size.



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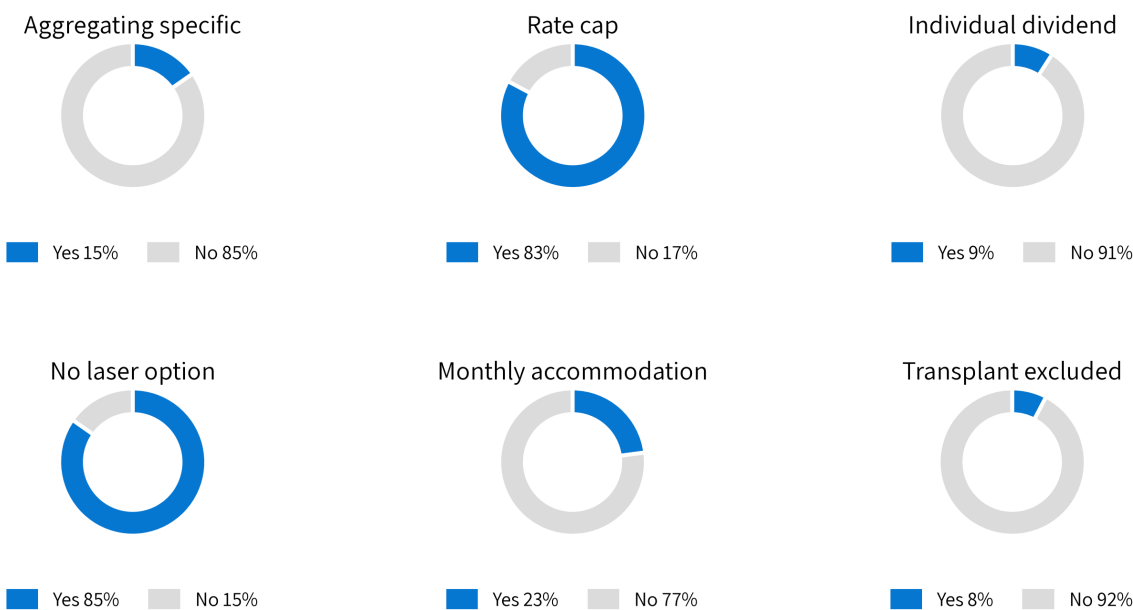


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Policy Options
