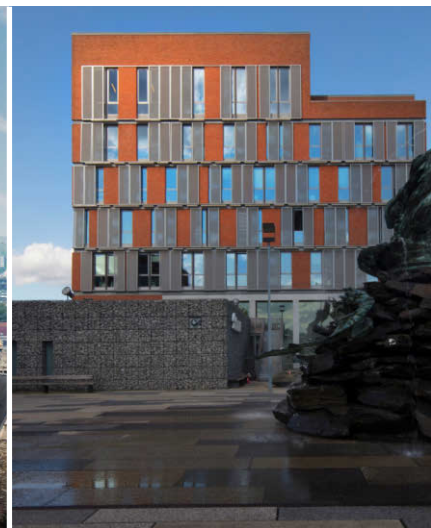

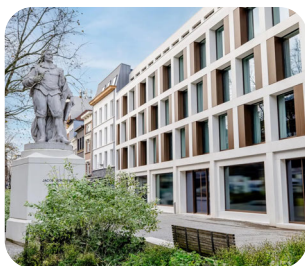


About the Event

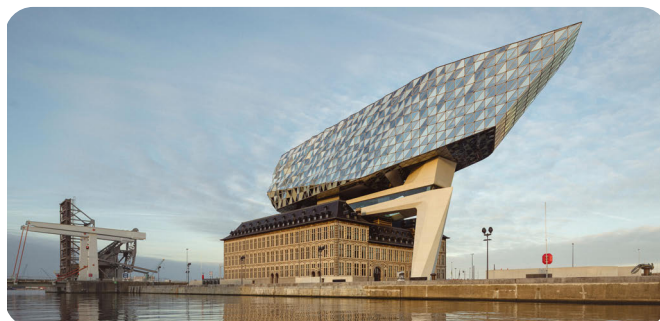

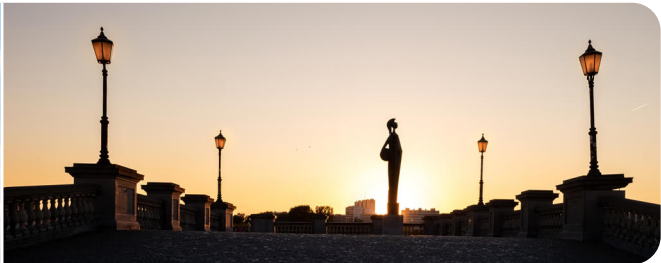
Welcome to the Havenhuis and opportunity to experience this remarkable building

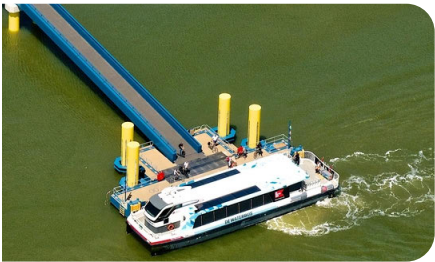
