Eurowag's purpose is to make commercial road transport clean, fair and efficient, and we recognise our responsibility to minimise our environmental footprint across all operations, products and services. This document establishes the principles that guide our Environmental Management System (EMS) and supports the delivery of the Group Sustainability Strategy and Action Plan. It applies to all Eurowag sites, stations, truck parks, offices and employees.

Eurowag is committed to responsible environmental stewardship by preventing pollution, reducing negative impacts, enhancing positive contributions and driving continuous improvement. This document supports compliance with the requirements of ISO 14001 and provides a foundation for setting environmental objectives, KPIs and improvement programmes.
