- doing our part in the global effort to mitigate the impacts of climate change, and taking steps to improve the resilience of our business activities to the impacts of climate change;
- contributing to the conservation of biodiversity by implementing integrated approaches to resource development and environmental management;
- integrating mine closure and progressive rehabilitation into the way we plan and execute our business activities;
- complying with applicable environmental legal and regulatory requirements as a minimum standard; and
