## **Texas Task Force Foundation 2026 Scholarship**

The Texas Task Force Foundation is a privately funded, non-profit organization established in 2020 whose mission includes awarding scholarships to Texas Task Force members pursuing their degree and to high school seniors who are children of current Texas Task Force members. Scholarships are awarded to those best personifying the dedication, hard work, and pursuit of excellence historically exhibited by the members of the Texas Task Force.

### **Eligibility**

1. The applicant must be a child of a current member in good standing on one of the Texas Task Force teams.
2. The applicant must be a fall 2025 or spring 2026 high school graduate.
3. The applicant must be a US citizen.
4. The applicant must become and remain a full-time student for at least two terms or semesters at an accredited university, college, or trade school in the year in which the applicant applies.
5. The applicant must not be in default of a federal or state loan or owe a refund on any previously received financial aid.
6. Children of current Texas Task Force Foundation officers or board members and members of their immediate families are not eligible to apply.

### **Award Amounts**

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to one applicant each year. This \$1,000 scholarship is renewable each semester by maintaining a 3.0 GPA and upon review and approval of the official transcript. Scholarship is renewable each semester for a maximum of 8 semesters or four (4) years. The Foundation's Board of Directors, at the recommendation of the Selection Committee, may also choose to award additional scholarships at its sole discretion.
