Participant Background & Entry

- Relocated from Wisconsin to Texas during height of COVID-19
- Entered HCV/CoC program during a period of housing instability
- Received timely support that enabled immediate housing placement

Program Impact

- Secured stable housing, allowing family to safely transition & remain housed
- Support provided critical stability during a global crisis
- Program assistance created a foundation for long-term self-sufficiency

Economic & Career Advancement

- Began employment as a call center representative earning ~\$32k/year
- Advanced to Retail Store Manager at Charter Communications Spectrum
- Current annual income: ~\$65,000
- Nearly 6 years of continuous employment w/ the same company

Family & Educational Outcomes

- Eldest child graduated HS w/ honors
 - Currently a junior at ACC pursuing an Art degree
- Younger children excelling in academics, athletics, and the arts:
 - Undefeated world champion flag football team member; Offensive Player of the Year
 - Active in AAU track and cross country
 - Participation in school choir performances across TX



Current Status & Program Exit

- Family is stably housed & thriving in Cedar Park, TX
- Voluntary exit from the program effective 12/31/25
- Participant chose to exit to allow another family to benefit from assistance

Overall Outcome

- Successful transition from crisis to stability
- Demonstrates the long-term impact on housing assistance on family self-sufficiency, education, and economic mobility.
