* Fragrance Notes are used when combining multiple fragrances. Ideally a fragrance from each Note will be included in the combination. As a general rule the ratio is Top: 15-25%, Middle: 30-40%, Base: 45-55%

* Example: Top: 3 drops, Middle: 4 drops, Base: 5 drops
