Board members were briefed by Patrick Howard on drafted strategic priorities for input/review.

VI. CEO / EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR's REPORT

A. Voucher Programs/ Homeless Initiatives - Christina Montes

Victoria Perez provided an update to the Board about the various programs HCV, Homeless Initiatives, and Special Purpose Vouchers.

- As of July 31st, 2021, the occupancy rate for the HCV program was at 100%
- 40 port-ins were absorbed in the month of July
- Currently 39 Mainstream Vouchers, 34 FUP Vouchers, 30 VASH Vouchers, 75 Non-Elderly Disabled Vouchers, and 32 Voucher holders actively searching
- Commissioner Wilmer Roberts inquired about the absence of Veteran Vouchers, in which Patrick Howard informed the Board that we don't have adequate support from the local VA.
- B. Affordable Housing Programs *Gabrielle Jones & Carlos Guzman*

Gabrielle Jones and Carlos Guzman provided the Board with a status update of the Affordable Housing Program.

- Vacancies: Eastern 11; Manor Town 2; Carson Creek 0; Alexander/Summit 6
- Currently 16 "Market Rate Renters", 23 "Zero Income Renters"

C. Real Estate Development – Robert Onion / Keith Hoffpauir

Keith Hoffpauir provided the Board with a status update on Eastern Oaks, Manor Town Phase II, and Travis County Facilities Corporation.

- Eastern Oaks 95% complete
- Manor Town Phase II RFP has been finalized
- Travis County Facilities Corporation Tech Ridge is 47% complete as of 8/5/21. The Marcus
 Project and Bercy Chen Studio LP/Cambrian Development are potential partners for "South First
 Apartments" & "Lamar at Koenig" projects

D. Finance – Subra Narayanaiyer

Subra Narayanaiyer provided the Board with the HATC June 30, 2021 Monthly Finance Report. This report reflects 12 months into the fiscal year 2021 which was extended to 18 months.

E. HATC Foundation – *Eric Lindholm*

Eric Lindholm provided the Board with a status update for HATC Foundation

- Three residents were recipients of HATC Foundation Scholarships
- On August 12th, the Back-to-School supply drive provided 40+ children with school supplies
- HATC Foundation has renewed its partnership with the Literacy Coalition of Central Texas (LCCT)
- UT School of Nursing has partnered with The HATC Foundation for health and wellness inquiries
