

1-2. Distribution of Overseas Koreans


Order: North America > China > Japan > South Asia & Pacific > Russia > Europe

Organizational Structure of the Overseas Koreans Agency




3-1. Purpose and Directions of Overseas Koreans Policy

3-3. This is how it will change in 2025.



They are now systematically supported to settle as members of our society.

- Customized educational programs tailored to each stage of resettlement, with a focus on capacity-building by age group.
- Support provided according to regional characteristics, including residence assistance,
 capacity-building for daily life, industrial and occupational safety, and social adpatation
- Support for domestic Koreans by private organizations based in Korea has been further strengthened.



Sakhalin Koreans

All children are eligible to return to the homeland together.

- Starting in 2025, not only one direct descendant but all children of Sakhalin Koreans will be entitled to apply for permanent resettlement support.
- For the first time, a fact-finding survey has been conducted on the living conditions of Sakhalin Koreans and their accompanying family members who have permanently resettled in Korea, and the findings have been reflected in the formulation of effective polic

3-4. This is how it will change in 2025.

Domestic Businesses This initiative has instilled confidence in their efforts to enter overseas markets and expand sales channels.

- The World Korean Business Convention held in Atlanta, United States, in April served as an opportunity to build networks with overseas Korean entrepreneurs and to condude export contracts.
- Participation in the World Korean Business Forum across diverse industrial sectors provides a platform for broadening export opportunities.



Overseas Koreans residing abroad

Access to domestic online services is now available without the need for a Korean mobile phone.

- Private digital signature certificates can now be issued to overseas Koreans without a Korean mobile phone through the non F2F identification system (Overseas Koreans Authentication Center).
- With the issued certificate, various online services can be accessed conveniently without mobile phone identity verification.

Domestic online services are now accessible without the need for a Korean mobile phone.

- ♦ A new communication platform, tentatively named OK TV, will be established and operated on a 24/7 basis.
- \diamondsuit A wide range of overseas Korean-related content will be provided in alignment with the daily schedules of overseas K
