The YFGA Outdoor Education Camp for youth aged 12-15 years old will be held July 1 – July 5, 2026, and is based at Lapie Lakes with activities taking place in the surrounding area.

Entry is limited to 12 participants from throughout the Yukon. To qualify for the camp, applicants must:

1. Complete a short letter on one of the two topics listed below (letters will be evaluated on content not grammar; letters should be approximately one page).
2. Be a member of the Yukon Fish and Game Association (family membership is required and costs \$35.00 for one year). The camp is free of charge to participants with a YFGA family membership.
3. **Submit your application no later than June 10th, 2026, at 4pm UTC -7 Yukon time.**
4. **Prior to attending the camp, campers must complete the online portion of the Yukon HEED course.** If an applicant already has HEED certification or has completed the online portion of the course, please include that information in your application.

Once you apply, you will be notified by phone and/or email by Monday, June 15th at the very latest.

Letter Topic 1: As someone who enjoys hunting, fishing, and spending time outdoors, how do you think you can help care for and protect the Yukon's natural environment? Why is stewardship important to you as a young outdoor enthusiast?

Letter Topic 2: Tell us about a memorable time you spent hunting, fishing, or backcountry camping. What made that experience meaningful to you, and what did you learn from it about nature, yourself, or outdoor skills?
