'Roots to Grow, Wings to Fly'

Ash Class: Year 1,2 & 3



In maths year 1 has come to the end of understanding the foundations of how adding and subtracting works, they used all their recently learnt skills to answer 1-digit and 1-digit addition or subtraction questions independently. Year 2 are applying their multiplication skills in various ways and are becoming really strong with their understanding. Year 3 are comparing different fractions to strengthen their understanding of how a whole can be made.

Different sentence types have been a focus in our English lessons. Whether a sentence is a command, statement, question or exclamation. The children have been identifying the different sentences, writing their own and changing sentence types to another. We are now using these different sentences in our newspaper report writing.

In Geography the children have finished their map work and are comparing The British Isles with Cape Town, South Africa. We are looking at the different/ similar physical and human features. Comparing harbours and ports; mountains and hills; different coastlines and specific attractions to the areas such as Table Mountain and Loch Ness.

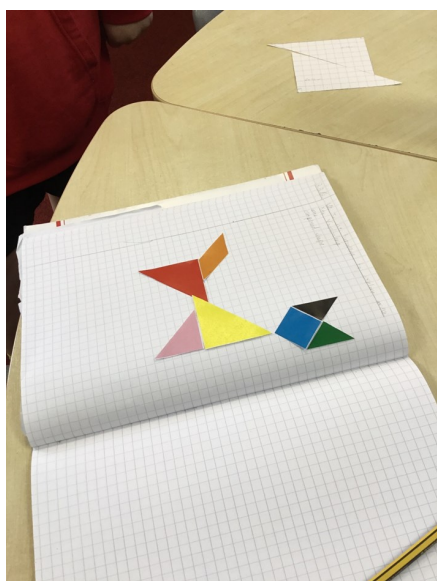


Oak Class: Year 4, 5 & 6

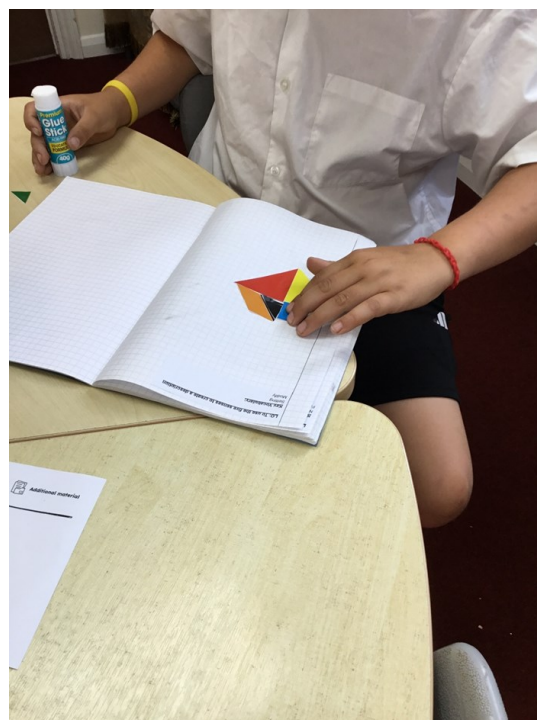

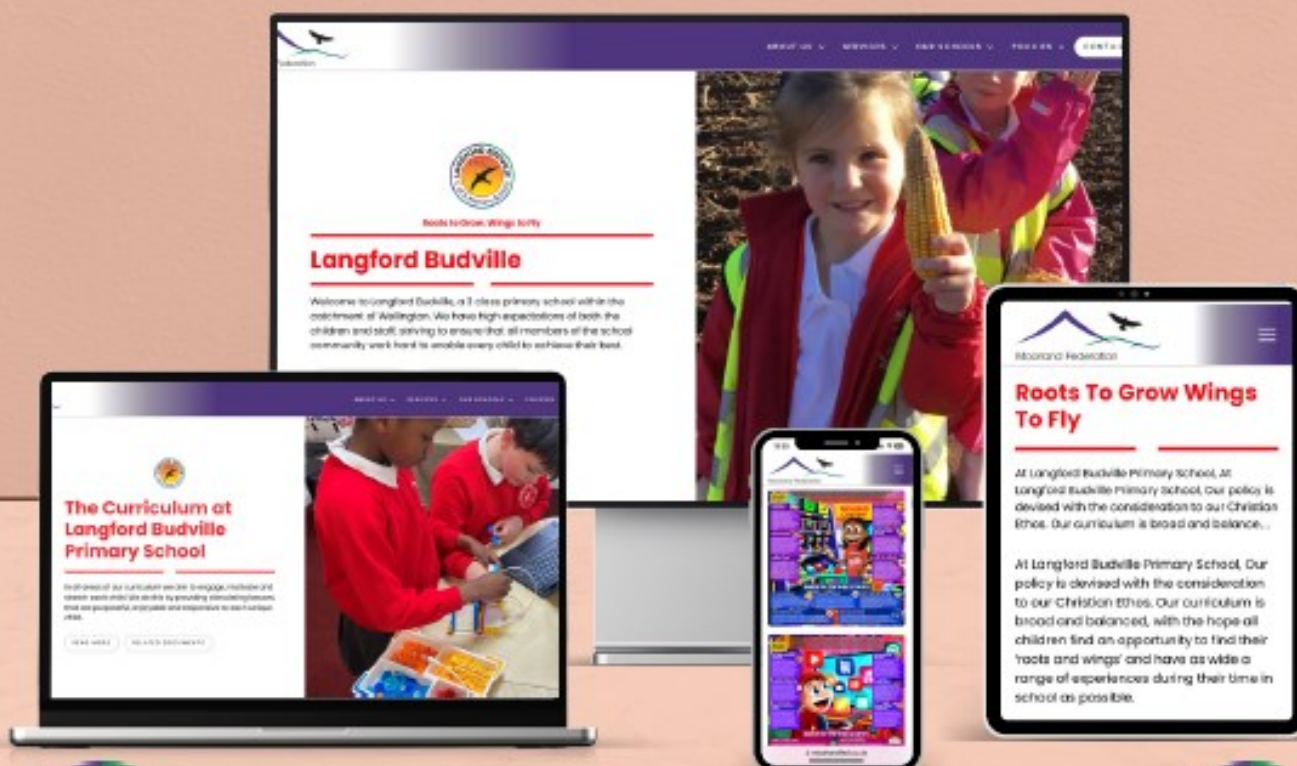

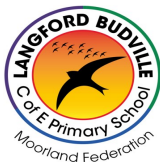
