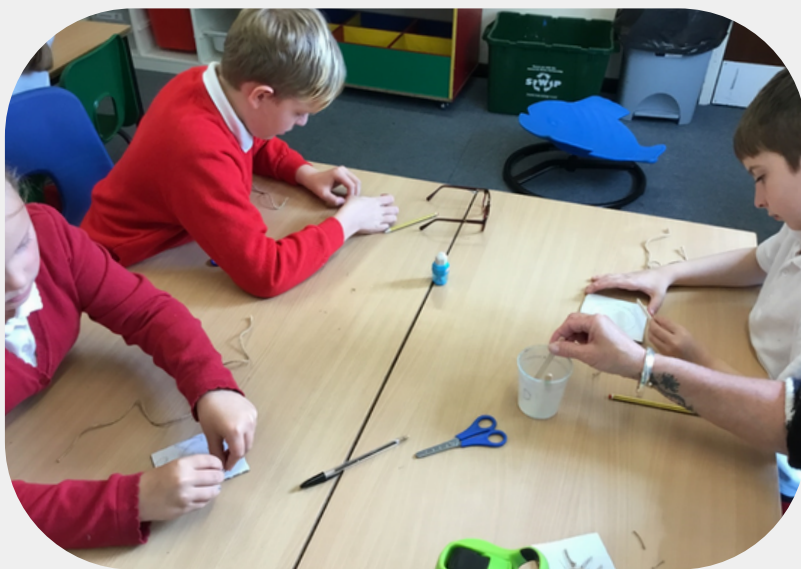
Message from ...
