## Message from ...

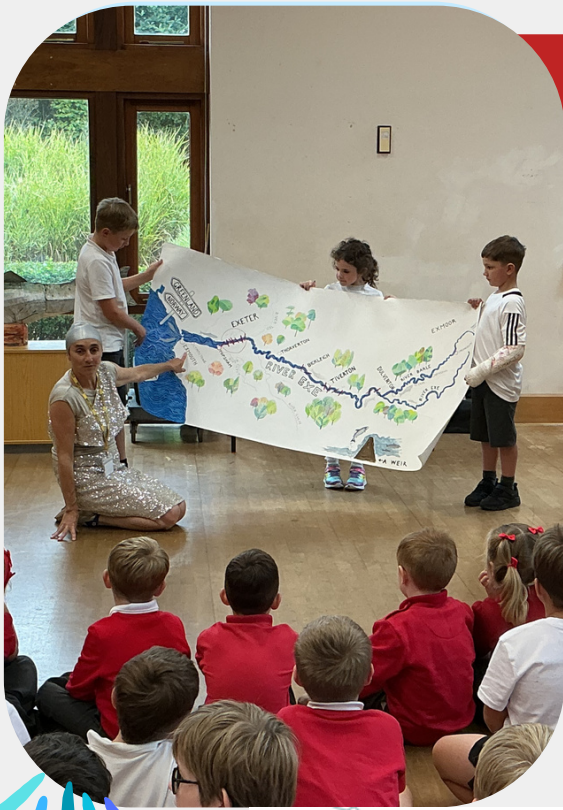

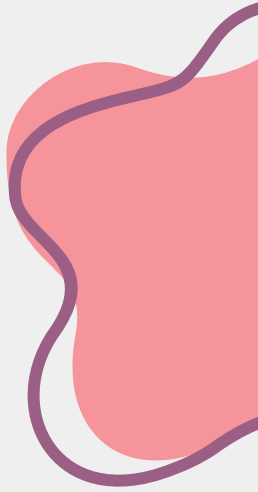
