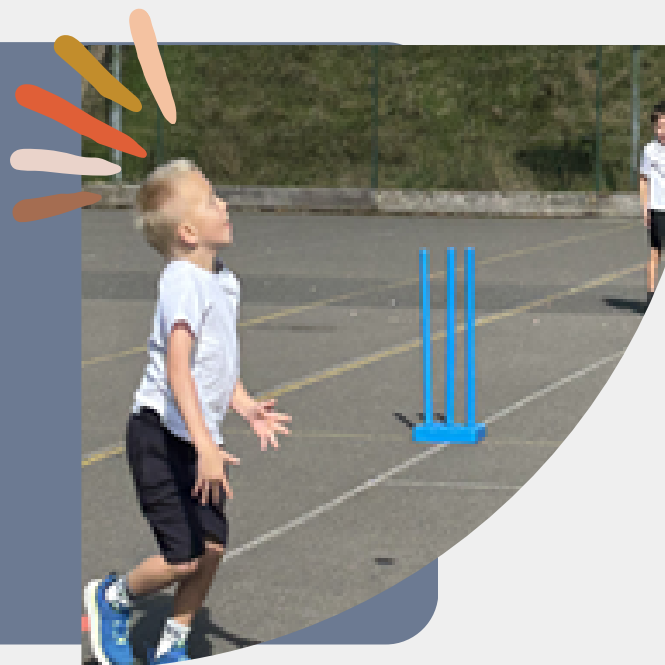


Haddon
