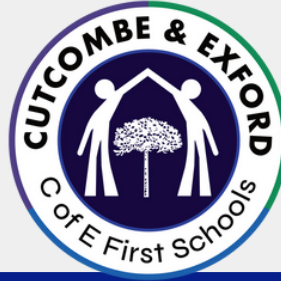


Our School Newsletter

Message from Mrs Blackmore

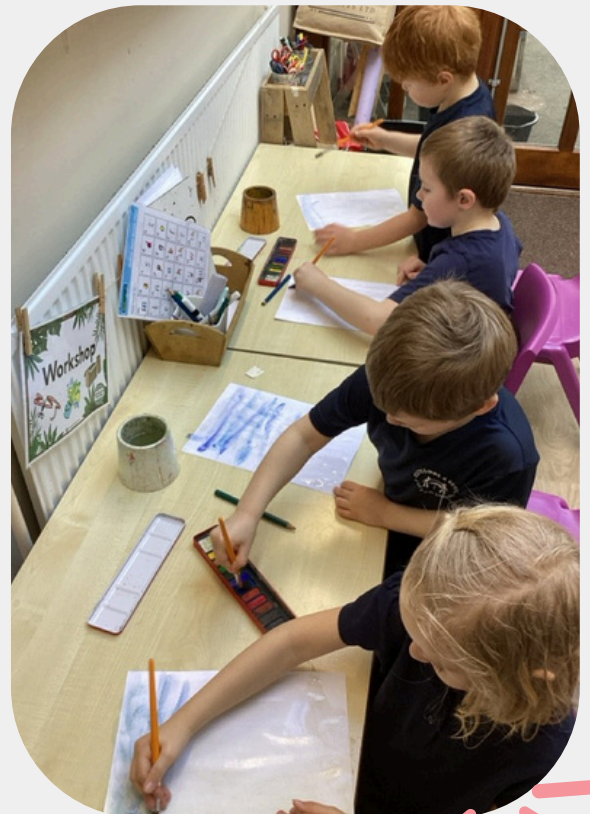
I am very proud of all the children for taking part in the village Remembrance Services. I have received positive comments from both communities about how engaged and respectful the children were.

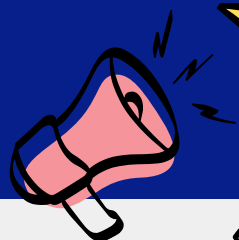
