To help us investigate, we carried out an exciting practical activity known as the egg and toothpaste experiment. Using eggshells to represent tooth enamel, we tested how well toothpaste can protect our teeth from sugary or acidic substances. The children loved observing the changes and discussing what they discovered. It was a fun, hands-on way to learn about dental health and the importance of looking after our teeth!




Burridge

Burridge have had another action-packed couple of weeks. Last Friday, we visited Nutcombe Bottom to practice some map reading and time keeping skills as well as learning about the geographical features of the area. This week, in science, we have been learning about natural selection, we undertook an investigation to understand how birds' beaks have adapted to suit the diet they eat. We tested different shape tools to pick up different foods and timed how many we could move in 30 seconds. We then drew conclusions from our results. We also researched the world's only flightless parrot, a strange quirk of evolution!


