Over the past two weeks we've enjoyed a wide range of exciting learning experiences. We took part in the RSPB bird survey, carefully counting and identifying birds in our local environment. Our outdoor learning was a real highlight, with plenty of creativity shown through making mud pies and rainy-day painting. In art, we've been learning about Andy Warhol, exploring his bold colours and iconic style through our own artwork.



Class 2

Class 2 have been looking at the story of Cinderella of the Nile in literacy. The children have now finished the book and over the next few weeks plan to write their own version of the story. In history the children have looked at Ancient Egypt and why the river Nile is important. In science the children conducted an experiment to see if items move faster on rough or smooth surfaces. All the children enjoyed this experiment and recording the results. In PE the children have been doing gymnastics this half term focusing on jumps.

Little Oaks enjoyed a week of learning about Ice, during the week they showed a big interest in Penguins. We found out lots of new facts about penguins, made our own with clay and played a penguin games outside.

The children also had a fun week learning about different modes of transport. They made their own name trains and practiced writing the letters in their name. They got creative making their own hot air balloon, building rockets with different shapes and learning how the electric Lego train works.

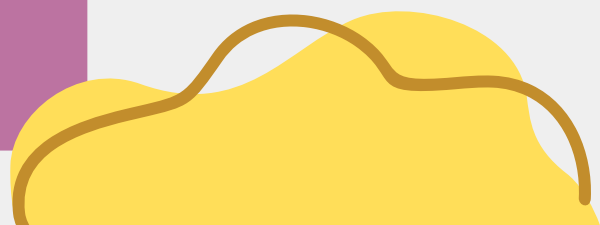
