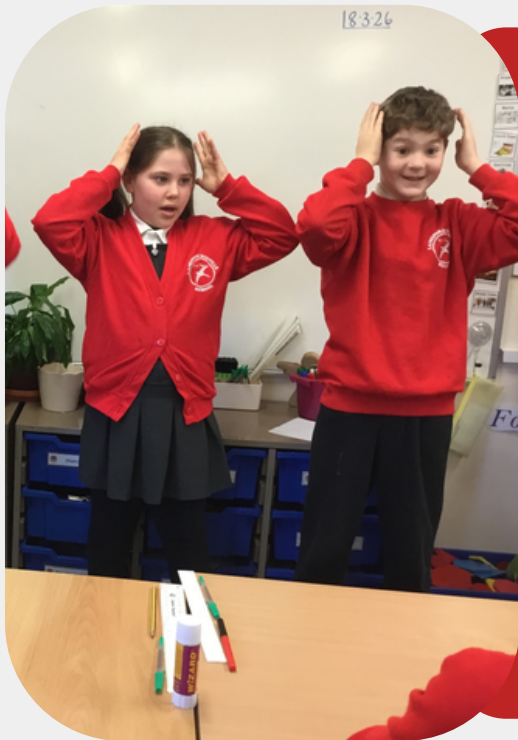


# Our School Newsletter

## Ash

Ash Class have been exploring ballads in music, learning Space Oddity by David Bowie and creating their own actions to go with it. In English, they have been practising how to use inverted commas to write dialogue. In DT, the children have been developing their sewing skills as they make their own Easter keyrings.

# Forest School

In our forest school sessions we have been enjoying the fresh buds of Spring, searching for lesser celandine, hazel catkins, blackthorn flowers and the first tree leaf buds bursting. We've used bowsaws and secateurs to clear footpaths of questing brambles and fallen branches, and we've come across the first leaves of wild garlic on the Triangle. Over the campfire we have made popcorn in sieves and cleaver tea, whilst in the coming weeks we are going to be collecting daisy and greater plantain to make our own soothing salves for bumps and stings.

We are looking forward to our Easter Service on Tuesday 1st April at 9.15am. Families are warmly invited to join us as we celebrate together.

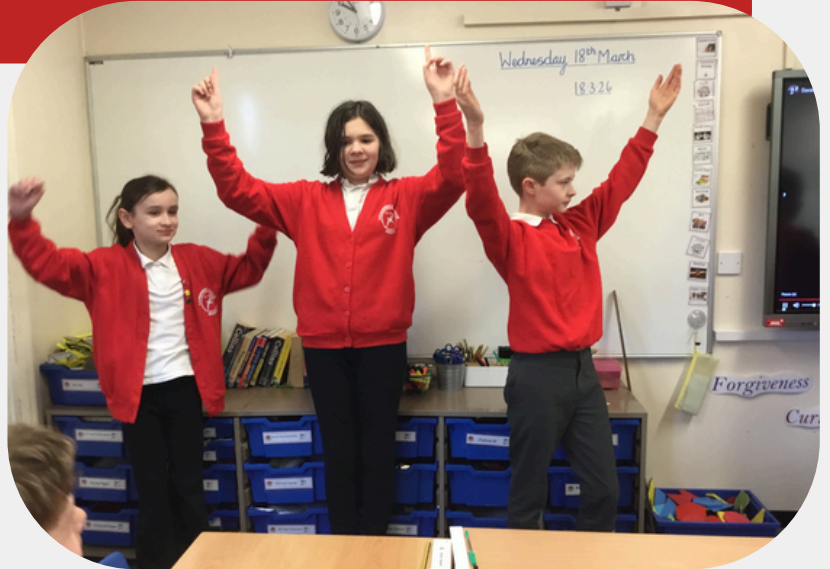

Thank you, as always, for your support and involvement in school life.





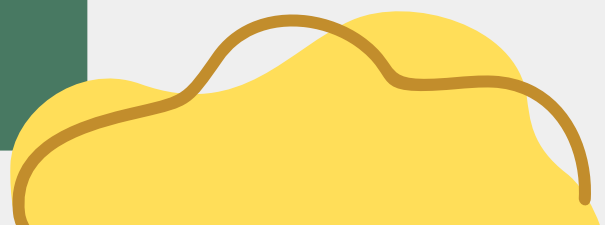

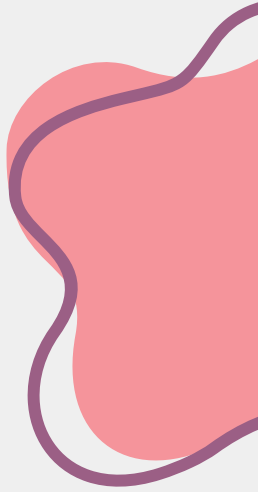
