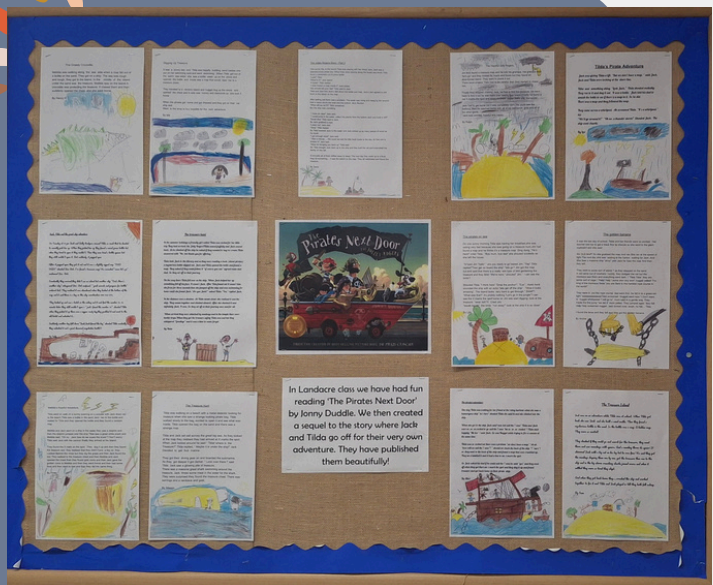


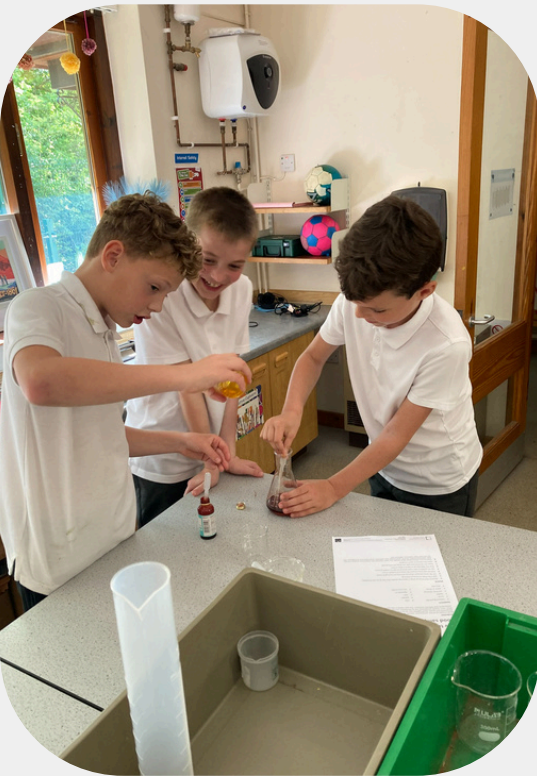
Haddon

We have had a super final two weeks of this half term. In maths the reception have been learning about capacity and the years 1 and 2 about measures. In forest school we have been using hammers and nails to create natural shapes on wood, then infill with wool wrapped around the nails. The focus in art is on mixing colours, using powder paints to create secondary colours. Lots of fun!

Landacre

In Landacre class we read a story about 'The Pirates Next Door'. The children really enjoyed it and we then planned, wrote and published our very own sequel to the story. Many of these included using ambitious vocabulary and inverted commas for speech. They worked very hard on them, well done to the children!!





Burridge

Burridge class have had a whirlwind couple of weeks. After an amazing effort from the year six students in their Sats and a small treat to reward their hard work, we have got straight back into our learning. In Science we have been learning about the circulatory system and how it works alongside other bodily systems to keep us alive and healthy. We have been learning about the most important parts of the system and the role they play in sustaining life. Continuing on from last week's studying and dissecting of pigs' hearts, this week we have been trying to represent the four parts of our blood. We used three different liquids to represent the plasma, platelets and white and red blood cells found within our blood. The class enjoyed creating the mixture before allowing it to settle and separate into layers, just like blood does in a centrifuge.

After half term, we will be gearing up for our end of year performance and our exciting residential to Barton Hall!

The Year 6's impressed me with their dedication to the SATS last week – well done to them all.

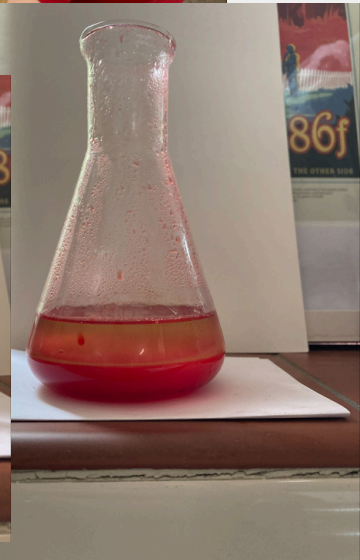

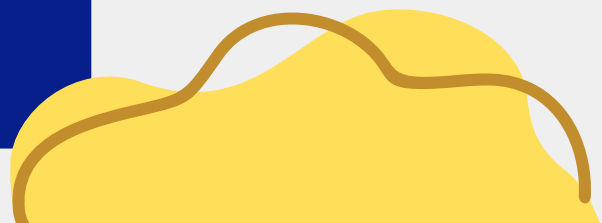

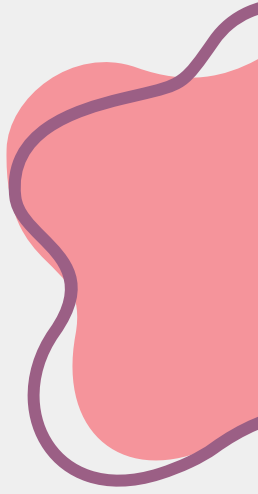
