

Special Rules

WHEREAS, the Assembly may only be convened for business for approximately one to two hours due to scheduling constraints with the hotel, and

WHEREAS, the business must progress smoothly and quickly in order to meet time constraints, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this General Session here assembled adopts the following Special Rules of Order.

Special Rules of Order.

Section 1: *Scope and Duration*. These rules shall govern the General Session assembled on June 20, 2026 and expire at the close of session.

Section 2: *Method of Voting*. Voting shall be conducted by electronic devices using the CCR app. Should members experience voting difficulties due to poor wifi, lack of device, etc. they may submit their vote to the secretary at the front table to be recorded.

Section 3: *Debate*. The following rules shall govern speech and debate on motions:

- A. There shall be no more than two speakers on each debatable item: one opposed and one in favor;
- B. Speeches shall be confined to one minute;
- C. There shall be no rebuttals;

Section 4: *Contested Election Rules*. The following rules shall govern speeches for candidates:

- D. Speakers shall be confined to two minutes;
- E. There shall be no rebuttals;
- F. There shall be no audience questions;
- G. Speakers may yield their time to others on their behalf;

Section 5: *Chairman nominations*. The following rules shall govern nominations for chairman:

- H. Nominating and seconding speeches for chair candidates shall be no more than 1 minute;
- I. There shall be no rebuttals;
- J. There shall be no audience questions;
- K. Speakers may yield their time to others on their behalf;

Section 6: *Board Alumni and Advisors*. Members of the Board of Directors whom are alumni or advisors, but are entitled to a vote in CCR elections by virtue of their Board role, shall be counted with the region in which they live for regional allocations.
