Update from Jeremy Thompson, Elementary School Principal

- First round of Iready and Amplify are in progress. School is trending for improvement in test grades.
- Kids are getting ahead in the areas they need extra help with.
- Q1 report cards going out soon.
- Kindergarten and First grade expecting a visit from the Lucia Riverbend Fire department
- Student government elections are taking place and organized by Cherry Renyolds. Leadership opportunities are available to students.
- Positive feedback from Book Fair and Movie Night. Looking forward to Raptor Run.
- Update from Dr. Jake Wilson, Middle/High School Principal
 - Working on AI training for staff. Including safety guidelines.
 - Jake and other leaders at MICS attended the ISTE conference on developing safe technology vendors. Working with Google Gemini - does not store any personal information.
 - Over last 2 years MS and HS have won over \$170K grants to further technology.
 - This is the second year MICS received a \$65K grant for afterschool programs and CTE.
 - Spectrum News was on campus to report on how our Middle School teachers are handling technical growth.
 - Middle School Athletics: New conference. Boys' soccer team finished the season with 7-0. Congratulations to the Middle School Cross Country, Volleyball and Football teams on their successful Fall season.
 - High School Athletics: New conference. Woman's Volleyball finished the season 14-0.
 - Recognized: DECA, Recycling Club, Debate Club and an investing club.
 - Sports Marketing Class is going well had 6 in person visitors and virtual guests.
 - PSAT taking place on 10/24. Note that it is also available to qualifying 10th graders.
 - AIG testing is done with 10th graders to qualify for dual enrollment.
 - AP classes and teachers have been added. Our AP scores have increased 26% over the last four years, which is higher than the national average.
 - We are working with the United Sports League. The league connects K-12 level peers with Special Olympics and other programs.

 - Set up will begin at noon and be completed by 4pm. Assistance needed for clean up after the event.





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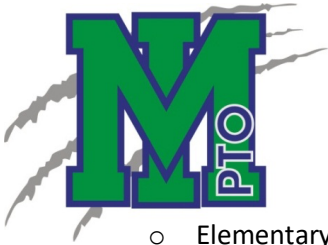
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- Haunted Hallways will occur at the same time. Keep an eye out for their ticket purchase link on Parent Square. Theme is Vampire Student Takeover.
