



Regulations for Uppsala Technology and Science Students' Association's event Puzzle Hunt Rally 2025

Definitions

1. *The Event* refers to the Uppsala Union Engineering and Science Students' Puzzle Hunt Rally.
2. *Rallykå* refers to the Puzzle Hunt Rally Committee of the Uppsala Union of Engineering and Science Students.
3. *UTN* refers to the Uppsala Union of Engineering and Science Students.
4. *Participant* or *team* refers to one or more people participating in a registered team in the Puzzle Hunt Rally.

Chapter 1. Introductory provisions

§ 1 It is the responsibility of each participant to know and follow the rules for participants in the Puzzle Hunt Rally. The regulations apply throughout the Puzzle Hunt Rally and at every location that is considered part of the Puzzle Hunt Rally.

§ 2 Violating these regulations may result in disqualification or suspension of participants or teams. In the event of a violation of the regulations, ignorance of the regulations is not considered an argument for avoiding possible disqualification or suspension. Disqualification applies until Rallykå deems that the participant can return to the event.

§ 3 In the event of illness, dissatisfaction or suspension, as well as unforeseen external circumstances that prevent or affect the completion of events beyond Rallykå's control (see Force majeure below), neither the participation fee, lunch tickets nor other expenses made in connection with the event will be refunded.

§ 4 Violations of Swedish law are reported to the police.

§ 5 Each participant must follow the instructions and requests given by Rallykå or Rallykå's designated volunteers throughout the event. Rallykå has the right to decide on all questions and disputes related to the event.

- ☐ **All team members** understand that as a participant in the Puzzle Hunt Rally you must follow the rules and instructions from Rallykå, and violations of the regulations or Swedish law may lead to suspension without refund.

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Force majeure

Rallykå is exempt from liability for the completion of all or part of the event in the event of unforeseen circumstances beyond Rallykås' control, which prevent or affect all or part of the event, such as accidents, fire, pandemic, war, enhanced emergency preparedness, riots, natural disasters, attacks from mythological creatures, fungal invasions, pollen in the air and the like.

Chapter 2. Safety and cheating

§ 1 Throughout the event, all participants must treat each other, volunteers, and Rallykå with respect and consideration.

§ 2 Careless behavior that endangers one's own safety or the safety of others will result in immediate disqualification.

§ 3 The team is responsible for taking care of team members who are unable to take care of themselves in a responsible manner. If a team member shows such signs and poses a risk to themselves or others, the team must act immediately. Failure to do so may result in the entire team being disqualified from the competition.

§ 4 Costumes or other behavior by the team that may be perceived by others as offensive is not permitted and Rallykå reserves the right to decide whether this may lead to rejection or disqualification.

§ 5 In the event of reasonable suspicion of cheating, Rallykå reserves the right to reject or disqualify a team.

- ☐ **All team members** understand that as participants they must show respect and consideration, take responsibility for their team members, avoid offensive clothing and behavior, and not cheat, otherwise they risk being disqualified from the event.

Chapter 3. Driving vehicles

§ 1 Only vehicles that require and are included in an EU category B driving license may be driven.

§ 2 Vehicles may not be driven by anyone who, due to illness, fatigue, the influence of alcohol, other stimulants or narcotics, or for other reasons, cannot drive the vehicle in a

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safe manner. In the event of reasonable suspicion of a driver being under the influence of the above-mentioned reasons, Rallykå reserves the right to reject or disqualify the team.

§ 3 During the Rally Day, drivers will be randomly selected for breathalyzer testing. If the driver refuses the test, Rallykå reserves the right to disqualify the team.

§ 4 Participants in the car must behave in such a way that the driver can drive the vehicle in a safe and legal manner. The driver may choose to expel a participant from the car if the driver believes that the participant is preventing the driver from driving the vehicle in a safe manner. In such a decision, Chapter 2 § 3 still applies.

§ 5 Decorations are only to be put up in a manner that does not obstruct the view out of the windows of the vehicle. Loose decorations on the outside of the car are not permitted.

- ☐ **All team members** understand which vehicle may be used and how it should be driven safely during the Puzzle Hunt Rally.

Chapter 4. Locations and equipment

§ 1 Participants in the Puzzle Hunt Rally are responsible for any property brought to the event. UTN or Rallykå are not responsible for lost or damaged property.

§ 2 UTN or Rallykå are not responsible for damage that occurs to vehicles or people during, or in connection with, the event.

§ 3 It is the joint responsibility of all participants to ensure that all places visited during the Puzzle Hunt Rally are left in the same, or better, condition than they were previously in.

§ 4 Participants are expected to do their best to prevent damage to objects at the locations visited during the Puzzle Hunt Rally. If damage to objects occurs due to carelessness, the participant may be liable for compensation.

§ 5 For everyone's well-being, all trash must be thrown into the designated containers. This applies to all locations covered by the Puzzle Hunt Rally.

- ☐ **All team members** confirm that they have understood that they are responsible for their own property, that **UTN or Rallykå are not responsible for damage** to vehicles or people. In addition to that participants must leave all places in good condition, prevent damage to objects, and throw all trash in designated containers.

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Chapter 5. GDPR

By signing these regulations, you give consent to UTN and Rallykå that further information and data may be used and stored for legal purposes until further notice.

Signing

The regulations must be signed by all participants in the team and all boxes in the regulations must be checked. The regulations are submitted digitally via the website. Please note that in order to sign, you must be 18 years of age, and for minor participants, a guardian's signature is required.

- ☐ **All team members** understand the consequences of violating the rules and agree to abide by the provisions above. **Insufficient reading does not constitute a valid excuse and may result in suspension.**
