## **2. Temporary Authorization for Online Payment and Disposition**

Effective **June 15, 2026, through August 3, 2026**, the additional cases listed may be disposed of through online payment using the Court's approved electronic payment platform without requiring an in-person court appearance, unless otherwise restricted by law, judicial order, or administrative policy.

Payment of the fine, fees, and applicable surcharges through the online system during this period shall constitute a waiver of appearance and disposition of the matter in accordance with applicable law and Court procedures.

## **3. Exclusions**

This Order shall not apply to:

- a. Cases involving defendants under 21 years of age at time of the offense.
- b. Cases involving suspended licenses, warrants, or other judicial holds requiring review;
- c. Cases otherwise excluded by judicial determination or administrative directive.

## **4. Authority of Judges Preserved**

Nothing in this Order shall limit the authority of any judge of this Court to require appearance, modify conditions of disposition, or otherwise act consistently with applicable law and judicial discretion.


## **5. Administrative Implementation**

The Clerk of Court, Court Administrator, and all appropriate Court personnel are authorized and directed to take all necessary administrative steps to implement this Order, including public notification, modification of procedures, website notices, and coordination with appropriate City departments and vendors.

**6. Expiration**

This Standing Order shall automatically expire at **11:59 p.m. on August 3, 2026**, unless extended, modified, or rescinded by further order of this Court.
