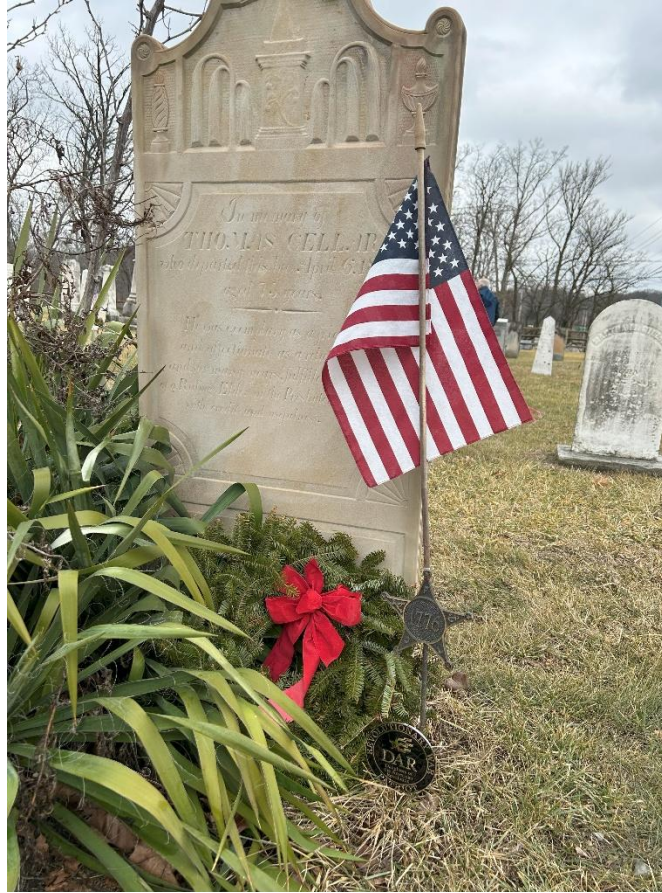




Estimated 34 tons dropped off in the 1<sup>st</sup> two years!



# Wreaths Across America Deconstruction Project



## **Wreaths Across America (WAA)**

WAA is a 501(c)(3) that was founded to continue and expand the annual wreath laying ceremony at Arlington National Cemetery.

In 2024, 3 million wreaths were placed in 4,909 locations by 4 million volunteers.

## 2023/2024 Pilot Project

- 1 Cemetery at Liberty Presbyterian Church  
Daughters of the American Revolution Delaware City Chapter
- 50 wreaths deconstructed





## Year 2: 2024/2025

- Liberty Church Cemetery - added 25 wreaths
- Added Radnor Cemetery (400 + wreaths)
- Added Oak Grove Cemetery (1300 + wreaths)
