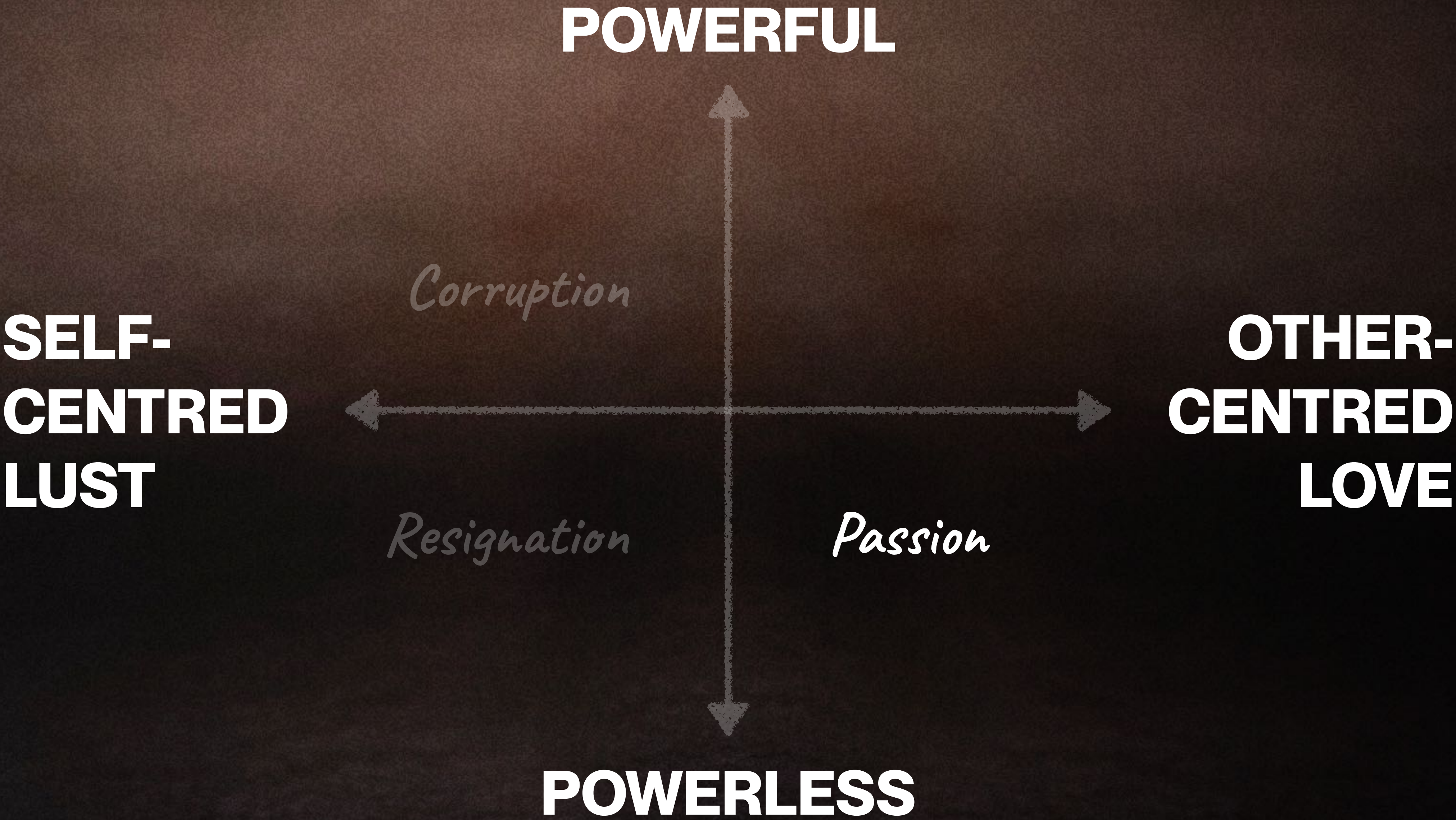
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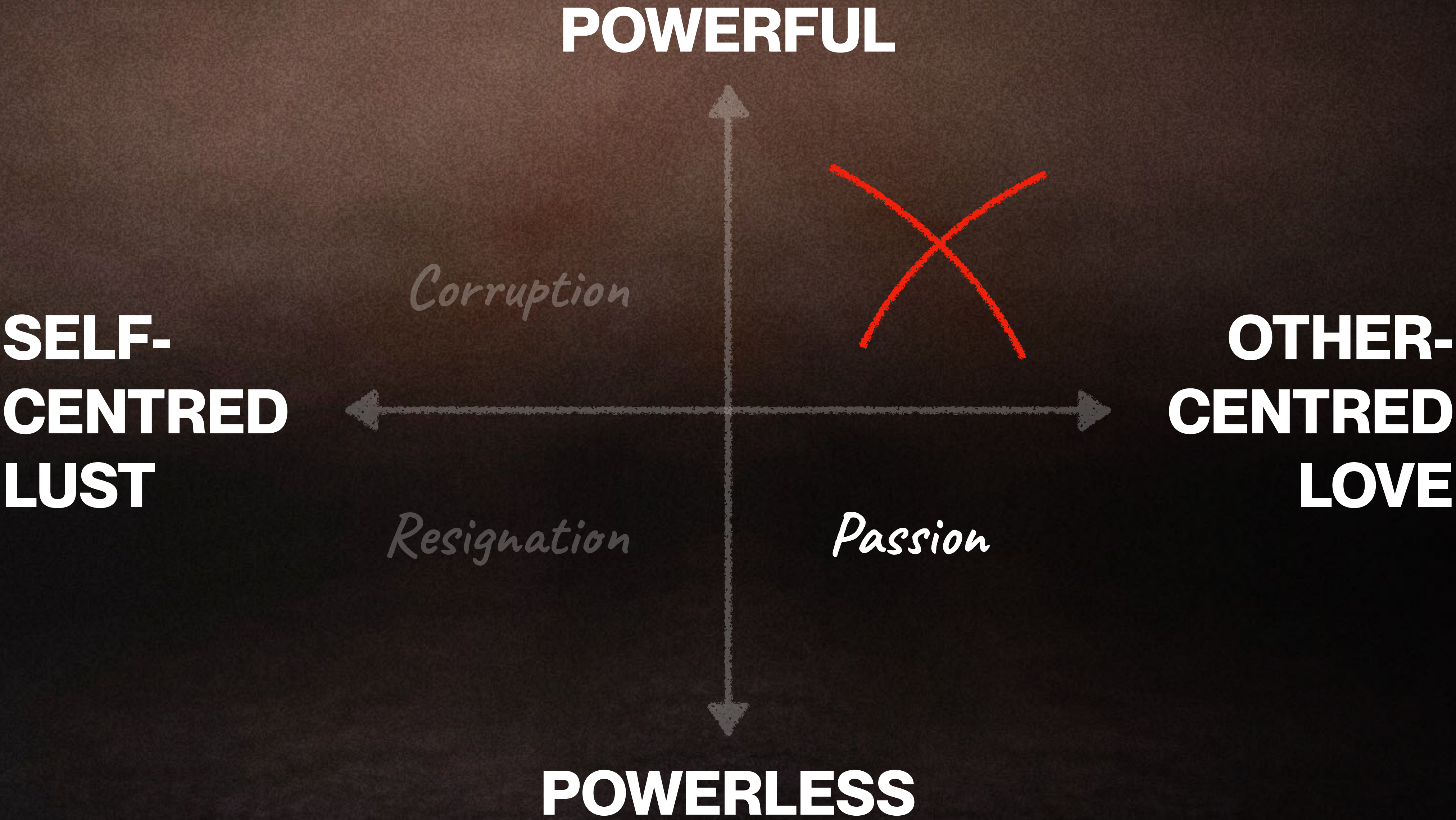




Philippians 2v5-8

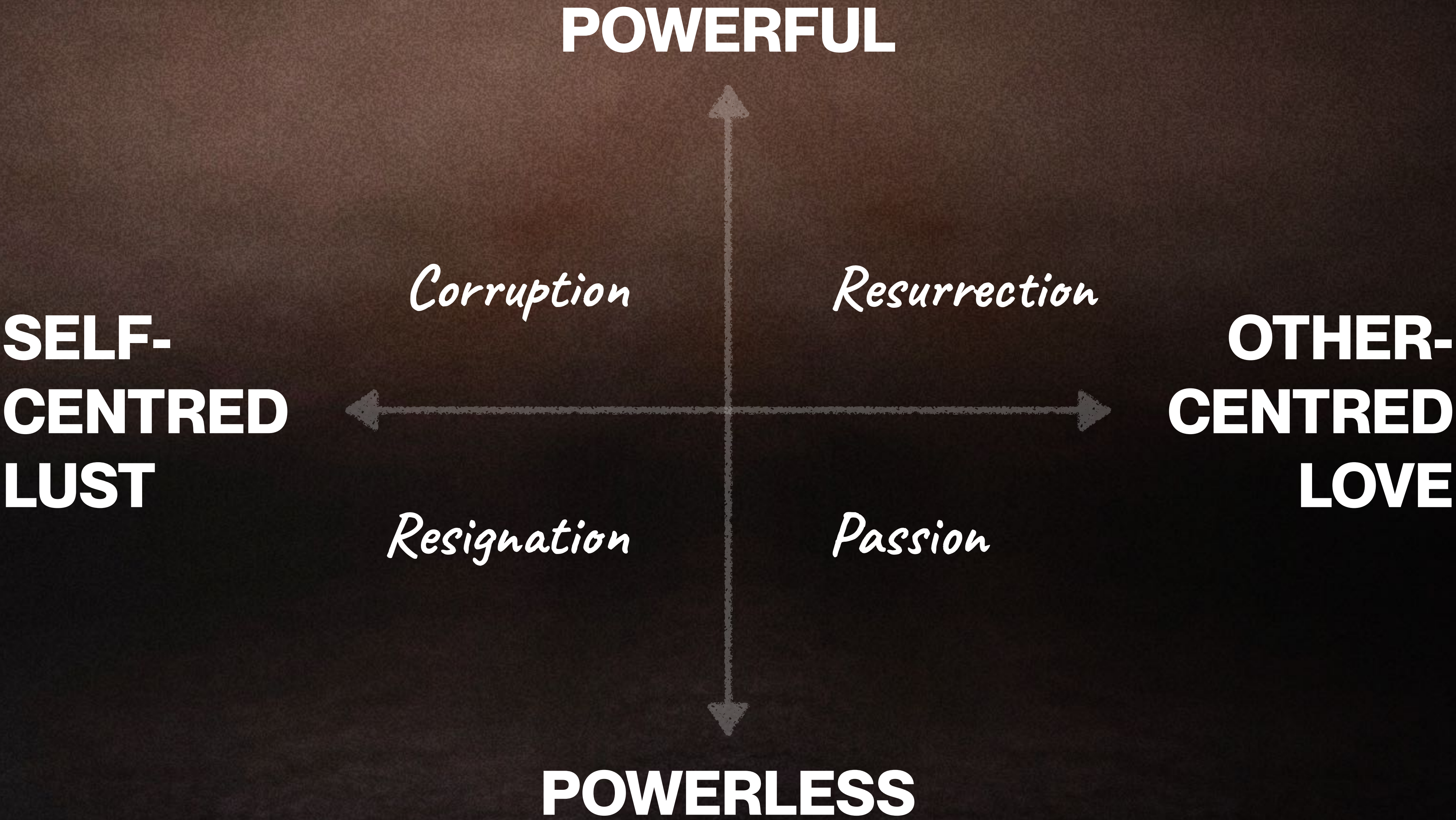


Philippians 2v9-11

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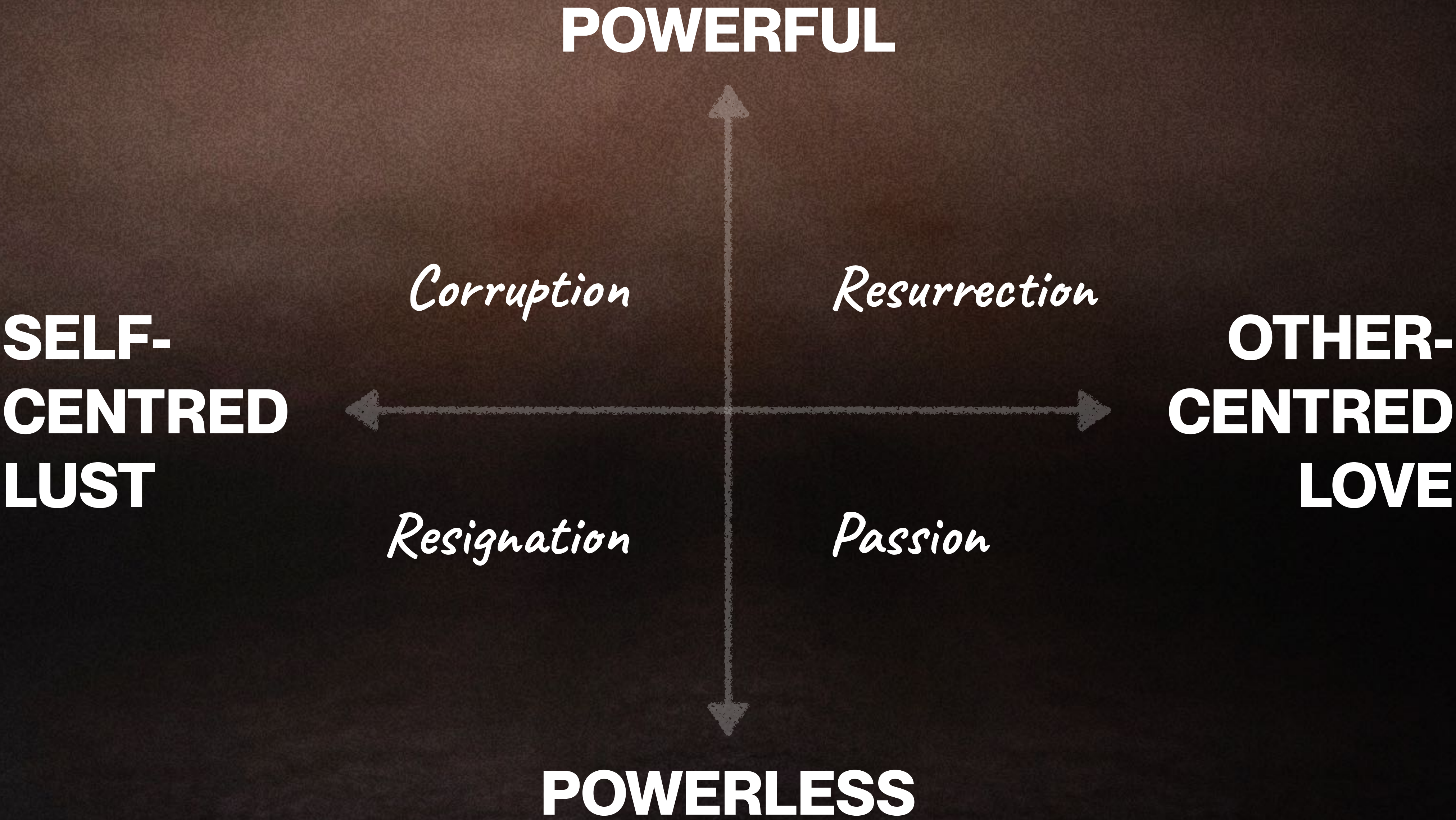


John 13v1-5

John 13v1-5
