CLAY PENCIL TOPPERS

This fun school craft is perfect for older autistic kiddos looking to practice more advanced skills.





WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Air-drying clay
- Pencils
- Plastic wrap
- Mod Podge
- Paintbrush

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Create the body of your pencil topper. Make sure it is large enough to sit on your pencil, at least the size of a quarter.
- 2. Create and add all of the other decorations to your pencil topper. It's important to do this before you place it on your pencil.
- 3. Once your design is ready, take a piece of plastic wrap and cover the eraser side of your pencil.
- 4. Gently push the pencil into the bottom of your design's body. Your design might get a little squished out of shape, but you can fix it as you go. Have someone hold the pencil for you if it is easier to adjust the design this way.
- 5. Once the design is on the eraser, place the pencil in a cup and allow your design to fully dry. Do not remove the pencil; without it, the hole could close while drying.
- 6. Once the design is dry, use Mod Podge and a paintbrush to add a layer of glue over your pencil topper. Make sure to add thin layers to avoid clumps on your design.
- 7. Allow the glue to dry before removing the pencil and the plastic wrap. Then it's ready for school!
