

HiTOP-SR Copyright Policy*

Copyright

The Hierarchical Taxonomy of Psychopathology (HiTOP) Pro (“HiTOP-SR”) is a self-report questionnaire consisting of 405 items. The HiTOP-SR, all versions of the questionnaire, and all related materials, including but not limited to, the test items, scoring algorithms, interpretive materials, and administration instructions, are protected by copyright laws. Copyright of the HiTOP-SR and all related materials is owned by the Hierarchical Taxonomy of Psychopathology Society (“HiTOP Society”). All decisions, modifications and approvals related to the HiTOP-SR are directed and approved by the Research and Publication Board of the HiTOP Society (“RPB of the HiTOP Society”).

Permission to Use

Subject to the restrictions set forth below, HiTOP Society grants permission to use the HiTOP-SR for non-commercial research and educational purposes. This permission is granted under the following conditions (CC BY-NC-ND Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives):

- **Non-commercial Use:** The HiTOP-SR may be used for research and educational purposes only. Any commercial use of the HiTOP-SR, including but not limited to, charging fees for administration, scoring, or interpretation, requires express written permission from RPB of the HiTOP Society. Selling access to the instrument, using it for profit-generating services, or incorporating it into commercial products all constitute examples of commercial use and are prohibited without explicit written permission and licensing agreement with RPB of the HiTOP Society.
- **No Modification:** The HiTOP-SR may not be modified, adapted, or translated without the express written permission of the RPB of the HiTOP Society. Any modification or adaptation of the HiTOP-SR may compromise its validity and reliability. Even minor modifications, such as changing item wording or response options, requires explicit approval from the RPB of the HiTOP Society.

Any approved modification or adaptation of the HiTOP Pro falls under the same copyright as the original and is the property of the HiTOP Society. All copyright stipulations regarding the HiTOP Pro extend and encompass any approved modifications of the original HiTOP Pro.

Terms of this copyright policy also extend to future versions of the HiTOP Pro developed by members of the HiTOP Society.

- **Attribution:** Any use of the HiTOP-SR must include appropriate attribution to HiTOP Society as the copyright holder.
- **Ethical Considerations:** The use of the HiTOP-SR must comply with all applicable ethical guidelines and regulations, including those related to the administration, scoring, and interpretation of psychological assessments.

LICENSING AGREEMENT EXAMPLE:

HiTOP-SR Translation License Agreement

This HiTOP-SR Translation License Agreement (the “Agreement”) is made and entered into as of [Date] by and between the Hierarchical Taxonomy of Psychopathology Society (“HiTOP Society”), a [State] [Type of Organization], and [Translator’s Name] (“Translator”). The Research and Publication Board of the HiTOP Society (“RPB of the HiTOP Society”) is the representative of the HiTOP Society and has authority to enter this agreement per the HiTOP Society bylaws.

1. Grant of License

1.1 **License Grant:** HiTOP Society grants to Translator a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to translate the HiTOP-SR into the [Target Language] language (the “Translated Work”).

1.2 **Scope of License:** The license granted herein is limited to the translation of the HiTOP-SR and does not extend to any other materials, including but not limited to, any derivative works or modifications of the HiTOP-SR.

2. Translator’s Obligations

2.1 Translation Quality: Translator shall use reasonable efforts to ensure that the Translated Work is accurate, clear, and consistent with the original English version of the HiTOP-SR. The final version of the translated work must be approved by the RPB of the HiTOP Society before any release.

2.2 Confidentiality: Translator shall keep confidential all confidential information of HiTOP Society, including but not limited to, the HiTOP-SR and any related materials.

2.3 Copyright Ownership: The Translated Work shall be the sole and exclusive property of HiTOP Society. Translator shall not claim any ownership rights in the Translated Work.

3. HiTOP Society's Rights

3.1 Review and Approval: HiTOP Society RPB shall have the right to review and approve the Translated Work to ensure its accuracy, quality, and consistency with the original English version.

3.2 Modifications: HiTOP Society may request modifications to the Translated Work at any time.

3.3 Termination: HiTOP Society may terminate this Agreement if Translator fails to comply with any of its obligations under this Agreement.

4. General Terms

4.1 Entire Agreement: This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous¹ communications, representations, or agreements, whether oral or written.

4.2 Governing Law: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York.

4.3 Dispute Resolution: Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be resolved through negotiation Research and Publication Board.
