NOTICE OF SECURITY BREACH

Dear Sir or Madam:

We are writing to provide a preliminary notification on behalf of Abbott Cancer Diagnostics (formerly known as Exact Sciences) of an incident that may impact certain data of New Hampshire residents requiring regulatory notice. We provide this preliminary notification via letter as the website portal does not permit submission without certain information which, at this time, is not yet determined. By providing this preliminary notification, we do not waive any rights or defenses regarding the applicability of New Hampshire law, the applicability of the New Hampshire notification statute, or personal jurisdiction.

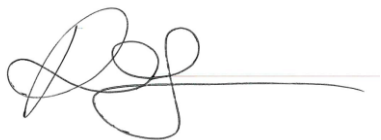
On July 8, 2026, we discovered indications of unauthorized access to a limited number of internal systems in our Cancer Diagnostics business only. The incident is contained.

Upon discovering the incident, we took immediate steps to address the situation. We have engaged leading third-party cybersecurity experts, outside counsel and law enforcement and are working diligently to further investigate the information accessed. We have also taken certain containment and enhancement measures, including disabling compromised user credentials.

Based on our investigation to date, we are aware that some of the impacted files contain personal and protected health information. We continue to thoroughly analyze the data and will provide more specific information as appropriate once we have completed our review, including making any required notifications to relevant individuals. Upon conclusion of the data review, we will provide an addendum to this report as needed.
