At the start of the day: At 8:40 your child should come in through the outside classroom door unless they are in Breakfast Club where they will be sent through the inside route to class. When your child enters the classroom, they should put away their equipment and start the morning activity set in class. Children should be settled in class and ready to learn by 8:50.

Should you wish to talk to us but are unable to get our attention at the class door, please send your child into class with a message for us to pop out and see you.

At the end of the day: Year 4 children are dismissed at 3:20 from their classroom to meet their adult at an agreed point on the school site to avoid pinch points at collection. Children should return to class if their adult is not at their meeting point and the classroom door will remain open/unlocked until at least 3:30. Should you need to discuss a safeguarding need and arrangements around this please contact your child's class teacher to discuss how we can help.
