IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW IN YEAR 1



PE TOPS

Plain black tracksuit trousers or shorts and plain black jumper or zipped plain black top with no images/ logos, markings or branding.



Please ensure that your child can put their trainers on and off independently and that they have Velcro trainers unless they can confidently tie shoelaces themselves.



SNACK

Your child should bring plain water in a named clear plastic bottle with a sport top lid which they can drink throughout the day.

During the morning, the children are given a piece of fruit through the 'Free Fruit for Schools' Scheme. Children can, if preferred, bring in their own piece of fruit for a morning snack.



SCHOOL LUNCHES



All children in KS1 are entitled to a Free School Meal at lunchtime and we recommend that all children take advantage of the range of free school meals on offer throughout the year.



HOMEWORK



We will be starting our home learning when we send home homework books in the first full week of September, once the children have settle in.

Homework will be set on a Tuesday and due by the following Monday, with a spelling test on that day.

SCHOOL UNIFORM:



- ✓ All children in Years 1–6 wear white shirts with a Widely Court tie.
- ✓ A green v neck jumper or cardigan (with or without the school logo).
- ✓ Grey trousers or a grey skirt or pinafore dress. Summer dresses/ school shorts may still be worn up until October half term and then after Easter for the summer term.
- ✓ White socks or grey tights
- ✓ Black shoes – please choose Velcro shoes unless your child is able to do their shoe laces independently.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW IN YEAR 1



NEW FROM SEPTEMBER:

To help promote kindness and avoid children feeling left out, **birthday party invitations are no longer to be brought into school for distribution unless every child in the class is invited.**

We understand that families have different circumstances and party sizes, but handing out invitations in school to only some children can cause significant upset and disruption in school. If invitations are for a smaller group, we ask that they are shared outside of school instead.



PLEASE LOOK AFTER OUR SCHOOL READING BOOKS.



We want all of our children to have access to good quality books.

Please **do not** put **water bottles** into bags to avoid leaks and damage to school books.



If a book is damaged in your care please replace the book with a quality second hand version.

PLEASE LABEL ALL SCHOOL CLOTHES/ WATER BOTTLES ETC.



They are very difficult to find and return to you if they do not have a name on them.



EARRINGS should be a plain gold or silver stud and children are **not allowed** to wear nail varnish.



LONG HAIR must be tied back off the face and must be out of children's eyes.



SUNGLASSES should only be worn if they are prescription sunglasses.



PLEASE ENSURE your child can take their shoes on and off independently and that they only have shoes with laces if they can do these up independently.
