Prior to joining Lingotto, Mr. Anderson was a Partner at Baillie Gifford from 1987 until 2022. He managed Baillie Gifford's flagship fund, the Scottish Mortgage Investment Trust, from 2000 until his departure in 2022. He led much of the Firm's growth strategy for decades, serving as co-manager across several funds, including the International Concentrated Growth and Global Outliers Strategies, the Long-Term Global Growth Strategy and the Vanguard International Growth Strategy, as well as through his many leadership roles.

James served as an Advisory Board Member for the government-sponsored Kay Review and chaired the subsequent industry working group, which established the UK Investor Forum. James is a Trustee of Johns Hopkins University, a member of the Investment Committee of University College, Oxford, and a non-executive Director at Heart of Midlothian Football Club. James graduated with a BA in History from the University of Oxford. After postgraduate study in Italy and Canada, he received an MA in International Affairs in 1982.
