COLLABORATIVE PARTNERS

New Richland - Hartland - Ellendale - Geneva (NRHEG) worked closely with Herman Manufacturing, a longstanding, family-owned business engrained in the community for over 50 years. They also leveraged funding with H2I and the 761 Foundation to compliment their project.

STUDENT IMPACT

60 students are enrolled in Ag Power classes at NRHEG annually. Through these classes, they gain skills using the newly purchased laser engraver to build skills that local employers are requiring. Manufacturing constitutes a large majority of jobs in south central Minnesota with 9 employers within a 20-mile radius of the high school currently hiring.
