



CHAPERONE GUIDELINES

1. Chaperones should follow all local and state laws.
2. A chaperone's conduct should positively always represent your school. Please be mindful of disrespectful language. Remember that your attitude influences the attitude of the students. If there is a problem with a particular student, talk to them individually and notify the counselor. Be mindful of actions that are not allowed by the school system for chaperones and students.
3. A chaperone should be proactive. Think through the events of the day and be prepared to solve problems before they happen.
4. Chaperones are responsible for all students, all the time. Do not leave the group unless there is an emergency.
5. Please join the students during the lunch period. School districts and/or chaperones are responsible to bring their own lunch. Please check with your guidance counselor on your lunch responsibility.
6. Chaperones will support the movement of students to their demonstrations. Maps will be provided along with SCC staff in the hallways to provide direction.
7. Chaperoning is an opportunity for great communication: Get to know the students. Get to know the other chaperones. Get to know the College staff and faculty while learning about the Career Pathways available to students in our region.
8. Chaperones are a huge part of our success! Enjoy the day with the students.
