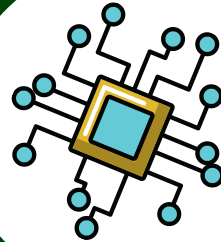

PROJECT OVERVIEW

What was purchased:

- 24 computers (District matched)
- Software: CAD, Fusion 360, Vectric V-Carve, Microsoft Office, and Adobe Design Suite

- increased course offerings at the high school - specifically in Business and Health pathways
- Full utilization of equipment such as 3D printers,, laser printers and more for fabrication

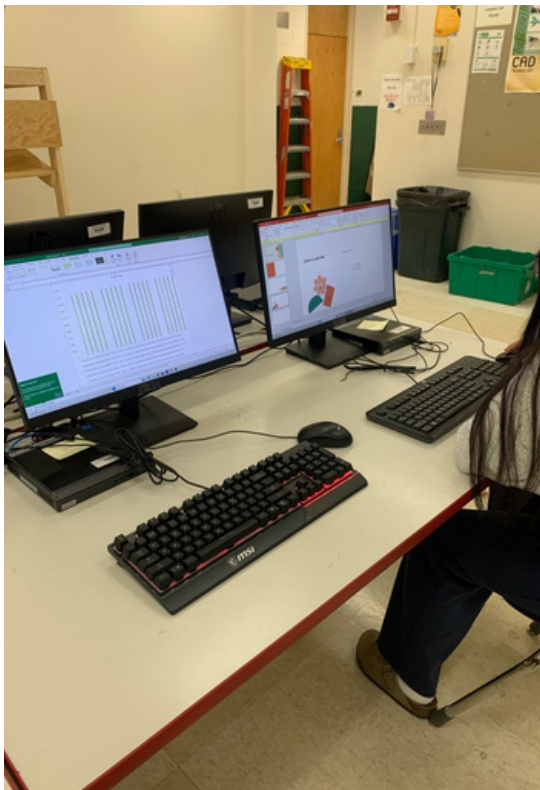
