

— THE SACRED VALLEY

The Sacred Valley of the Incas is set at a lower elevation than Cusco, offering the perfect environment to acclimatise while surrounded by dramatic Andean landscapes. Dotted with traditional villages, fertile plains, and important archaeological sites, the valley provides a deep connection to Andean culture, history, and daily life.

TUE, APRIL 21

TRAVEL TO CUSCO & THE SACRED VALLEY

Embark on a scenic journey from Lima into the heart of the Andes, travelling through Cusco and onward to the Sacred Valley. This day blends cultural encounters, traditional craftsmanship, and a gentle acclimatisation to altitude amid spectacular landscapes.

MORNING

FLIGHT TO CUSCO & SCENIC DRIVE TO THE SACRED VALLEY

The morning begins with a private transfer to Lima Airport for the flight to Cusco.

On arrival, guests are welcomed and, accompanied by Shermeen, continue on a private 1½-hour scenic drive into the Sacred Valley of the Incas.

At this lower elevation, you'll have time to relax, acclimatise, and enjoy your scenic surroundings. Along the way, you will have the opportunity to visit Sulca Museum, which preserves ancient textile-making techniques. Browse the fabric-dyeing area featuring displays of various natural dyes and how they are applied to textiles, and watch a weaving demonstration.



21-23 April



PISAC MARKET

Continue to the local village of Pisac, famous for its colourful market, which attracts travellers from all over the world. Try your hand at bartering for local sweaters, ponchos, wall hangings, jewellery, local handicrafts, and unique souvenirs. Make sure to bring your camera.



LUNCH

HACIENDA HUAYOCCARI

Lunch is enjoyed at Hacienda Huayocari, tucked away within the lush, vegetation-filled private estate of the Lambarri-Orihuela family in the village of Huayocari.

The hacienda houses the owners' private collection of pre-Columbian, Incan, and colonial artefacts, including an impressive selection of queros, the traditional ceremonial drinking vessels. Before heading to the lunch area, you are invited to browse the museum with a welcome pisco sour in hand.



ARRIVAL & LEISURE TIME

WED, APRIL 22

SACRED VALLEY: CHINCHERO, MORAY & MARAS

Discover the Sacred Valley through a full day of exploration across traditional villages, remarkable Incan sites, and dramatic Andean landscapes.



MORNING

CHINCHERO

The morning begins in Chinchero, a small Andean village located high on the windswept plains of Anta. The village is characterised by adobe houses, and locals continue their daily life dressed in traditional attire. From here, enjoy sweeping views over the Sacred Valley of the Incas, with the Cordillera Vilcabamba and the snow-capped peak of Salkantay dominating the western horizon.

Chinchero's most notable attraction is its colourful local market.

MORAY

The journey continues to Moray, an impressive system of circular agricultural terraces reaching depths of up to 100 metres (330 feet), believed to have functioned as an Incan crop laboratory using micro-climates.



LUNCH

DELUXE PICNIC

Enjoy a picnic lunch while admiring the stunning views of the Andes Mountains.



AFTERNOON

MARAS SALT MINES

Continue on to Maras, home to the famous salt pools. Still in use today, the salt mines consist of thousands of small pools, or pocitos, each yielding approximately 150 kg of salt per month. Walk along the narrow paths and watch locals harvest the salt using techniques that have remained unchanged for thousands of years.

MACHU PICCHU

Machu Picchu is one of the world's most remarkable archaeological sites, set high in the Andes and surrounded by cloud forest. Exploring this ancient Inca citadel with an expert guide offers insight into its history, sacred spaces, and architectural mastery.

THU, APRIL 23

OLLANTAYTAMBO, MACHU PICCHU & THE INCA CITADEL

Experience one of the world's most extraordinary archaeological sites through a carefully paced journey combining ancient history, dramatic landscapes, and immersive exploration.

MORNING

TRANSFER & OLLANTAYTAMBO

The morning begins with a transfer to Ollantaytambo Train Station, accompanied by Shermeen and a local guide.

Before boarding the train to Machu Picchu, you will visit Ollantaytambo, a charming village that preserves the original designs of Inca buildings. Among its most impressive features are the ceremonial temple dedicated to the worship of water and the imposing stone fortress that once guarded the entrance to the valley against invasions.



23-24 April

VISTADOME OBSERVATORY TRAIN TO MACHU PICCHU

Departure from Ollantaytambo Train Station aboard the Vistadome Observatory Train to Machu Picchu. Through panoramic windows, enjoy the unfolding landscapes, celebrate Andean culture in the bar carriage, and admire the dramatic route revealed from the observation carriage.

ARRIVAL & TRANSFER TO THE CITADEL

Upon arrival, you will be met by the hotel's representatives, who will assist with your luggage. Your local guide will accompany you on a short walk to the buses for the 30-minute ride to Machu Picchu Citadel (8,000 ft / 2,432 m.a.s.l.).



AFTERNOON

GUIDED VISIT OF MACHU PICCHU

The afternoon is dedicated to exploring the enigmatic citadel of Machu Picchu during a three-hour guided visit. Archaeological and historical insight is shared across key areas of the site, including Intihuatana (the Sun Dial), the Sacred Plaza, and the Temple of the Sun.

Surrounded by cloud forest, Wayna Picchu, and Inti Punku (the Sun Gate), the visit offers time to absorb the powerful energy and atmosphere of one of the world's most significant archaeological sites.

FRI, APRIL 24

MACHU PICCHU SUNRISE & RETURN TO CUSCO

Experience a final morning at Machu Picchu, combining optional hikes, continued exploration of the site, and a scenic return journey through the Andes to Cusco.



MORNING

SUNRISE AT MACHU PICCHU & OPTIONAL HIKES

The day begins early with a bus transfer to Machu Picchu, offering the opportunity to experience the site at sunrise - a moment many consider the highlight of a visit.

You have the option to complete one or two of the following hikes:

- Huayna Picchu, one of the highlights of Machu Picchu, offering extraordinary views over the Citadel and surrounding landscape from the summit.
- Machu Picchu Mountain, a challenging yet rewarding hike featuring large granite steps and sweeping 360-degree views from the top.

The remainder of the morning is spent continuing to explore Machu Picchu, allowing time to further absorb the atmosphere of this remarkable site.

Discover Cusco through a half-day city tour offering insight into daily life, colonial heritage, and the fusion of Inca and Hispanic cultures.

MORNING

SAN PEDRO MARKET

The morning begins at San Pedro Market, located in the heart of the city and one of the most visited places in Cusco. The market provides fresh produce for locals and offers an authentic glimpse into everyday life in the city.

CUSCO HISTORIC CENTRE

The exploration continues to the Main Square to visit the Cathedral of Cusco, the mother church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Cusco. Beyond its role as a place of worship, the cathedral houses an important collection of colonial art, archaeological artefacts, and religious relics.

The visit concludes at Koricancha Temple, one of the most striking examples of how Inca and Hispanic cultures fused together. Once the ancient Peruvian Sun Temple, its foundations were later used to build the Santo Domingo church and convent, making it a powerful symbol of cultural coexistence.
