Older students do not need something different from others who are learning to read: the same alphabetic code knowledge and phonics skills underpin all reading.












What is phonics?







Virtual Classroom films

How do I use the Virtual Classroom?

- 1. Set aside 10 minutes to watch a film with your child each day.
- 2. Find a quiet space for your child to watch the film on a laptop or tablet.
- 3. Praise your child as they join in with the lesson– make it fun!

The more they practise using these films, the quicker they'll learn to read.



What can I do?

- 1. Use Sound Talk to help your child to read and spell words.
- 2. Encourage your child to read their Module, Anthology or Fresh Start reader.
- 3. Watch the Virtual Classroom films together.
- Read aloud to your child every day.
