Top Tips for Reading!

Make books a part of your family life - Always have books around so that you and your children are ready to read whenever there's a chance.

Join your local library or school library - (Nearest public library, Kirkby Town Centre - The Centre, Norwich Way, Kirkby, Liverpool L32 8XY). It's free! You'll find a fantastic range of books to suit every child's taste. Allow them to pick their own books, encouraging free choice.

Match their interests - Help them find the right book - it doesn't matter if it's fiction, non-fiction, poetry or comics. There is no such thing as the "wrong" book!

Get comfortable - Snuggle up somewhere warm and cosy and read a book with your child or make sure they have somewhere comfy when reading alone.

Ask questions - To keep them interested in the story, ask your child questions as they read.

Read whenever you get the chance - Audio books are also great too, especially for long car journeys.

Read again and again - Encourage your child to read every day. Re-read favourite books and poems. Re-reading helps to build fluency and confidence.
