is for arctic




The Arctic is a very cold place with lots of snow and ice. Polar bears and seals live there.

A dog is a friendly pet that likes to run and play. Dogs bark and wag their tails.




An elephant is a big animal with a long trunk. It uses its trunk to grab food and spray water.

is for grasslands.




Grasslands are

is for horse.




A horse has a long tail and strong legs. It can run fast and carry people.






An iguana is a lizard with scaly skin and a long tail. It likes to sit in the sun.

A monkey has a long tail and loves to climb trees. Monkeys are playful and smart.

A narwhal is a whale with a long, twisty tusk. It lives in cold ocean water.



is for owl.




An owl is a bird that stays awake at night. It has big eyes and says "hoot." is for penguin.

is for quail.




A quail is a small bird that lives on the ground. It has a short tail and makes funny sounds.
