





is for arctic

A cat is a furry pet that likes to nap and purr. It can chase mice and play with toys.

d

is for dog.



A dog is a
friendly pet
that likes to run
and play. Dogs
bark and wag
their tails.

e is for elephant.



An elephant is a big animal with a long trunk. It uses its trunk to grab food and spray water.

f

is for fish.



A fish lives in the water and swims with its fins. Some fish are small, and some are big.

g

is for grasslands.



Grasslands are wide, open areas with lots of grass. Many animals like zebras and lions live there.

h

is for horse.



A horse has a long tail and strong legs. It can run fast and carry people.

i

is for iguana.



An iguana is a lizard with scaly skin and a long tail. It likes to sit in the sun.

j

is for jungle.



A jungle is a warm, wet place with lots of trees and plants. Many animals like monkeys, snakes, and birds live there.

K

is for kangaroo.



A kangaroo has strong legs and carries its baby in a pouch. It hops instead of walking.

L is for lion.



A lion is a big cat with a loud roar. It lives in the grasslands with its pride.

m is for monkey.



A monkey has a long tail and loves to climb trees. Monkeys are playful and smart.

is for narwhal.



A narwhal is a whale with a long, twisty tusk. It lives in cold ocean water.

An owl is a bird
that stays
awake at night.
It has big eyes
and says "hoot."

p is for penguin.



A penguin is a
bird that cannot
fly. It waddles
on land and
swims in the
sea.

is for quail.



A quail is a small bird that lives on the ground. It has a short tail and makes funny sounds.

r is for rabbit.



A rabbit has long ears and soft fur. It hops and eats carrots and grass.


S is for savanna.

t


is for turtle.

u


is for umbrella bird.
