Overburdened staff

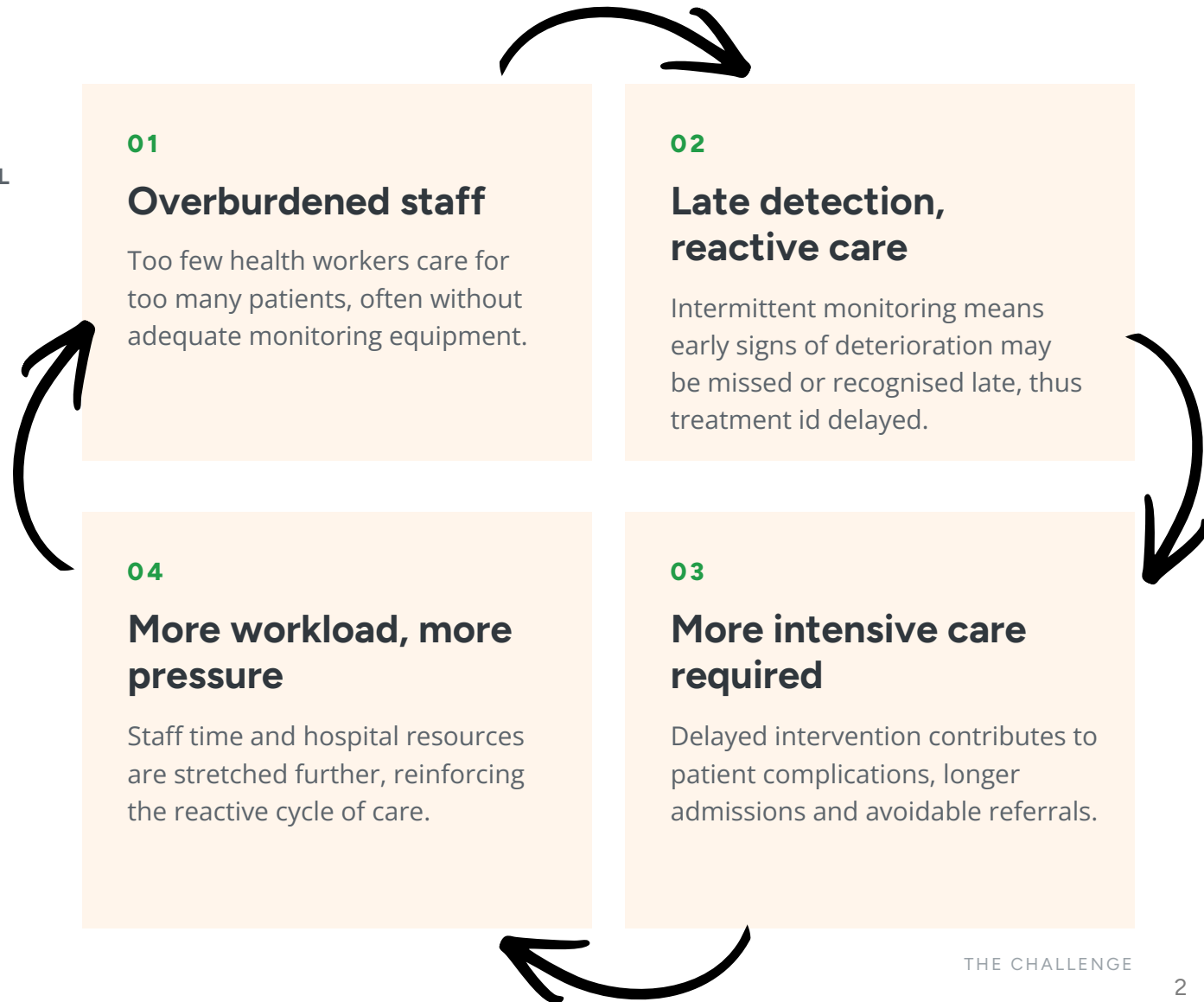
A shortage of qualified staff and adequate equipment keeps low-resource hospitals in a reactive cycle of care

HEALTH WORKER SHORTFALL
ACROSS AFRICA

Africa has just 1.55 health workers per 1,000 people, 65% less than the WHO recommended benchmark of 4.45.

The result is greater pressure on health workers and poorer outcomes for the patients in their care. Access alone does not guarantee timely, high-quality care.

Built for context continuous vital sign patient monitoring that unburdens health workers and transforms patient outcomes

01 — IMPALA MONITOR

Built for Sub-saharan Africa

Heat resistant up to 45 degrees, Dust and insect resistant, 10 hour battery life, resilient against power fluctuations



Silicone protective sleeve

The sleeve protects the IMPALA monitor from impacts while simultaneously preventing UV damage.



Reusable probes

Reusable and robust sensors, available for every age group from neonate to adult.



Smartphone like screen

Easy to use interactive screen allowing healthworkers to easily navigate and understand patient data



Specialised alarms

Five paediatric alarm thresholds and one for adults reduce alarm fatigue, with up to 54% fewer alarms.

Software, hardware and data to improve workflow efficiency, and reduce healthworker burden.

Wall-mounted in the ward, it shows the status of every monitored bed so the team can see where attention is needed first.

IMPALA server hub

A reliable on-premise hub with **on-site data storage, 24-hour power backup, a local WiFi network** and automated remote updates.

Mobile 10" tablet

Carried in the ward, bringing the patient overview and clinical support to the bedside.



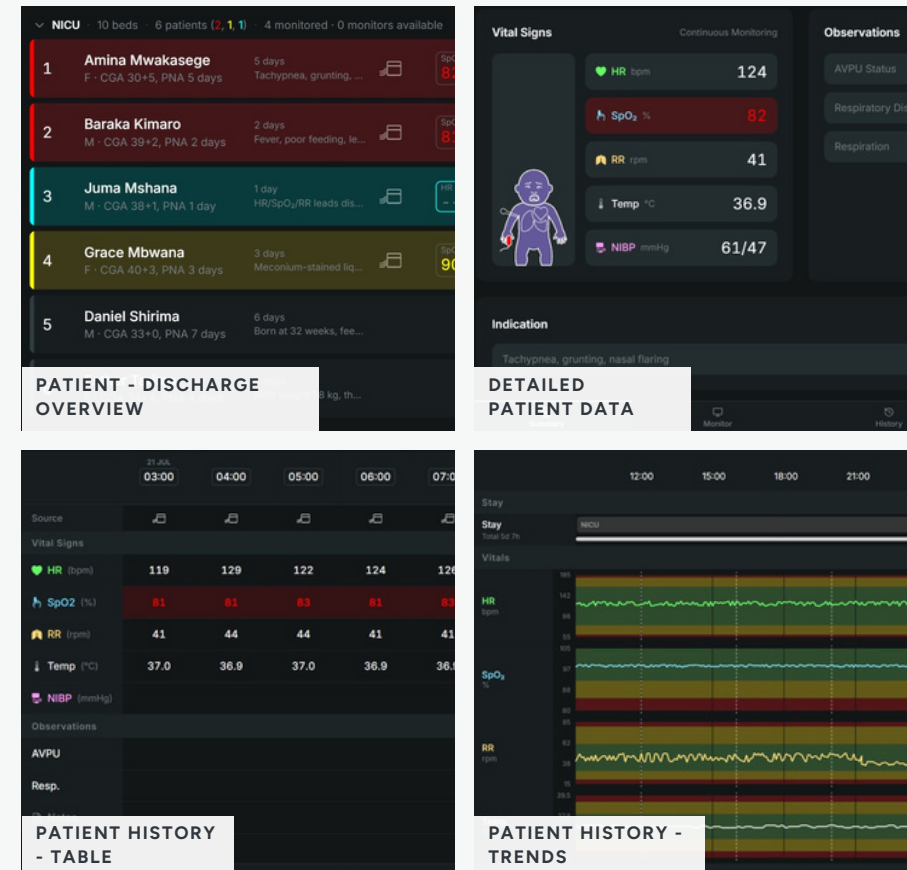

- Mobile and flexible display on multiple tablets/ screens of up to 30 monitors

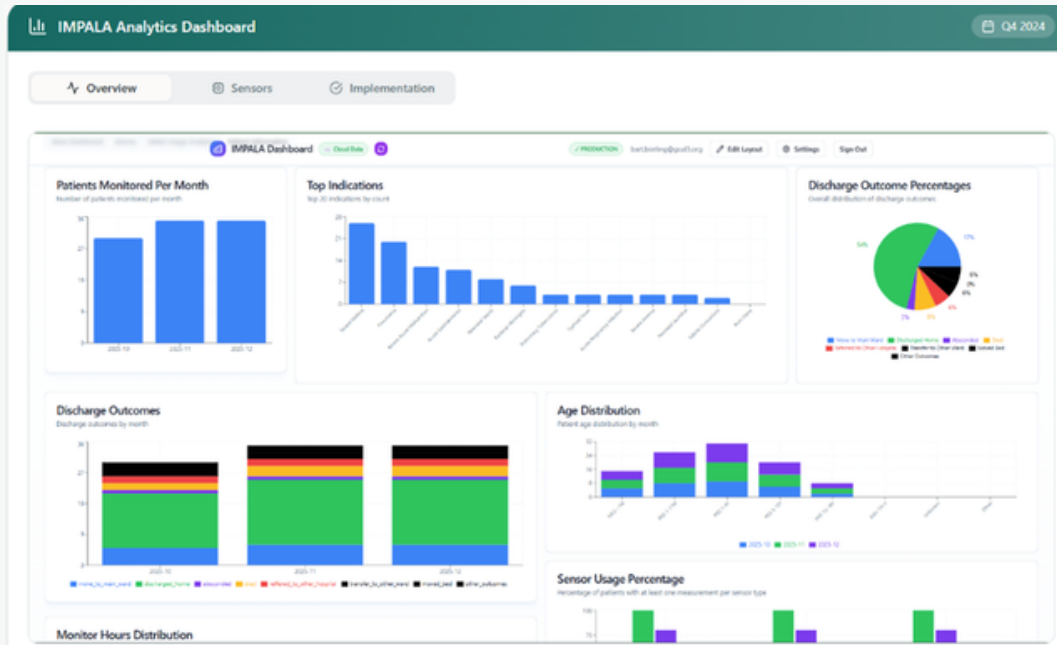


Clinical support application

Guidance at the point of care: patient history for up to 1 year after discharge, detailed patient data and hourly history as a table or a trend graph. *Expected that intermittent monitoring is available Q1 2027.*

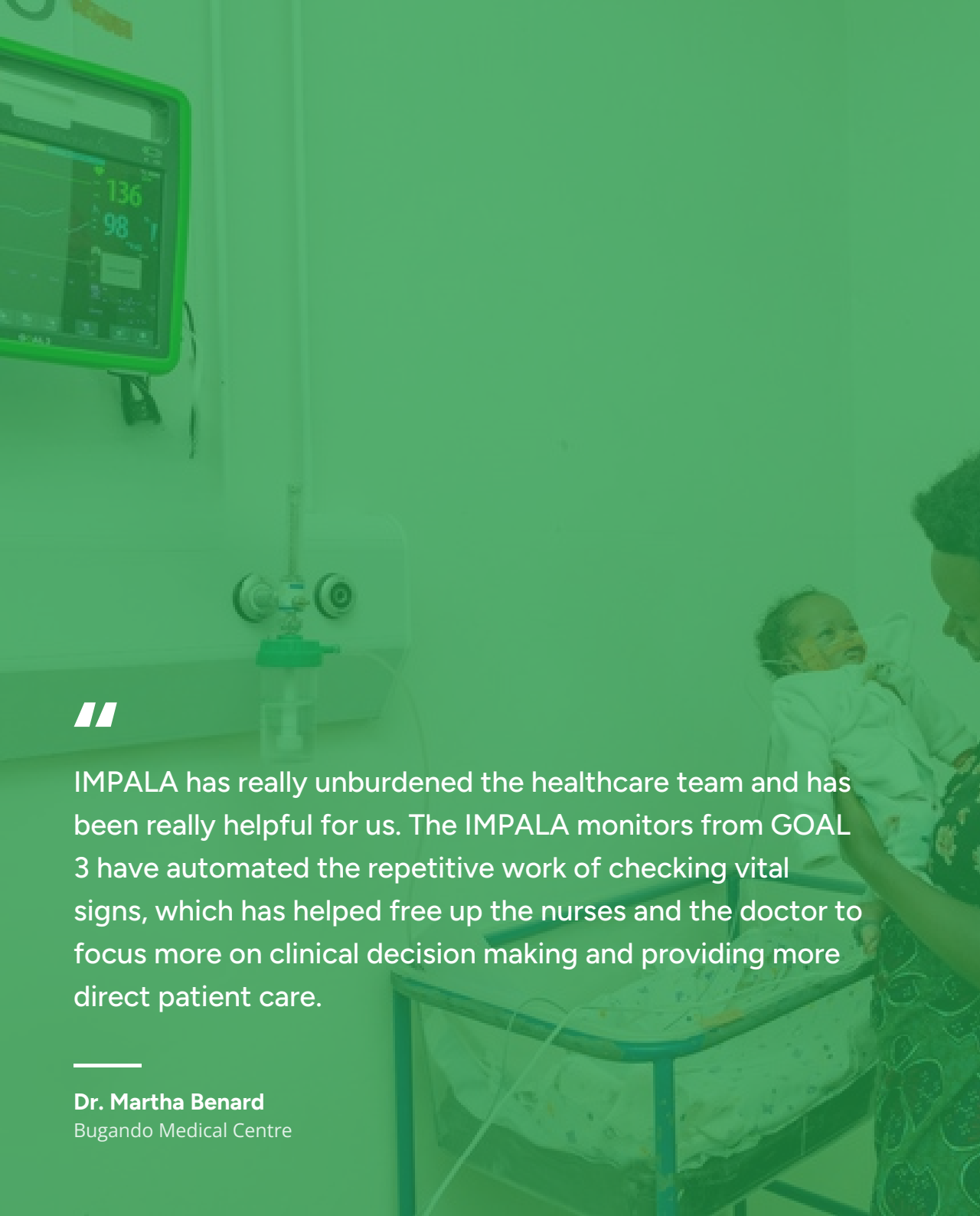

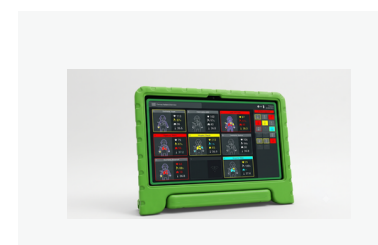
