The role

Help us turn AI into everyday leverage. You'll design workflow automations and internal tools, such as RAG systems, that put our knowledge at everyone's fingertips, and you'll automate our ESG reporting on top of our shared data model.

You may for example, include:

- Building a RAG assistant for our internal knowledge base so colleagues can ask questions in plain language and get sourced answers from policies, playbooks, and project docs.
- Creating ESG/impact data pipelines and a report generator that ingests indicators into our central model, runs checks, and keeps numbers up to date by default.
- Standardize reports and decks: create accurate documents and PowerPoint presentations from a single source of truth, with consistent visuals and a transparent review process.
- Designing with governance in mind: citations by default, logging, privacy-aware defaults, tests, and alerts.

Qualifications we hope you bring

- You're enrolled in higher education with ~2–3 years left; comfortable coding in Python or TypeScript and using SQL.
- Curiosity about LLMs (prompting, embeddings, vector DBs) and solid data-engineering basics.
- Interest in how data & AI improve decisions and how they can support sustainability.
- A responsible mindset about data ethics and privacy.
- A proactive approach and an eager will to contribute.
