Communities disproportionately impacted by economic disparities face a decrease in basic financial literacy and a growing wealth gap at rates higher than white populations.

Basic financial literacy is the ability to make sound financial decisions day-to-day and in planning for the future. Budgeting and investing are the basics of personal finance. Without these skills, families struggle to make ends meet and achieve economic well-being, and those who are not financially savvy are more likely to fall victim to scams and money-making schemes. Achieving financial literacy is the key to thriving in today's increasingly complex world.

Everyone needs financial literacy, but underserved communities, impacted by structural factors that expand the wealth gap, do not benefit from generational financial literacy in the same way as white populations and men do. It's time to break that cycle.

Financial illiteracy influences almost every facet of life—housing, food, and overall quality of life. 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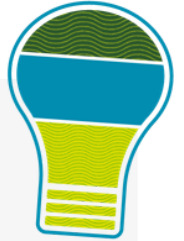
FINANCIAL LITERACY DISPARITIES

Financial literacy gaps remain significant across race, age, and education levels.



GENERATIONAL GAP

- Gen Z (18–29): 38% literacy
- Baby Boomers: 55% literacy



AVERAGE FINANCIAL LITERACY SCORES

- White & Asian adults: 50%+
- Hispanic adults: 38%
- Black adults: 34%

Cost of Financial Illiteracy: Financial mistakes cost Americans an average of **\$948 per year**, totaling over **\$246 billion annually**.

CHILD POVERTY & THE WEALTH GAP

Poverty continues to disproportionately impact children of color in the United States.

CHILD POVERTY RATE (2025)

13.4% of U.S. children
(approximately 10 million children)

- Black children — 22.7%
- Hispanic children — 21.5%
- Native American children — 19.8%
- White children — 9.6%
- Asian children — 6.7%



RACIAL WEALTH GAP

2025 Median Wealth

- Asian households — \$536,000
- White households — \$285,000
- Hispanic households — \$61,600
- Black households — \$44,900

In a dynamic 60–80 minute session—offered both virtually and in person—students learn how to set meaningful financial goals, manage spending, build savings, understand credit, and harness the power of compound interest. COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS

Our Preparing for College & Careers curriculum empowers students to take charge of their future with confidence and clarity. Through engaging 60-minute sessions (offered in person or virtually), students gain practical, real-world skills in college and career planning, financial literacy, and goal setting.

DRAGONFLIES MENTORING BOYS CLUB

Our year-round, community-based DragonFlies Mentoring Club empowers boys in grades 3–5 to grow into confident, kind, and purpose-driven young leaders. Meeting the first Saturday of every month in Charles County, Maryland, the program provides a safe and supportive space where boys build self-esteem, develop healthy habits, and strengthen character.
