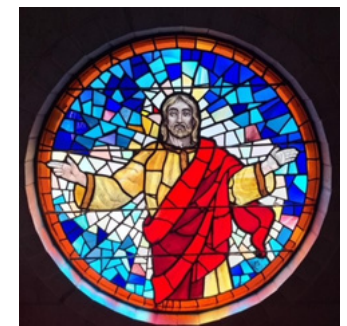
Welcome to Church
