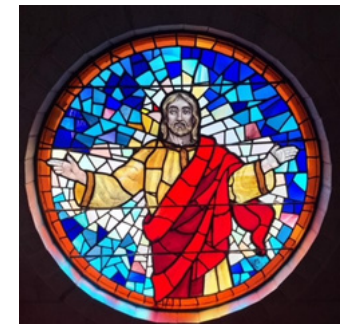
## Welcome to Church
