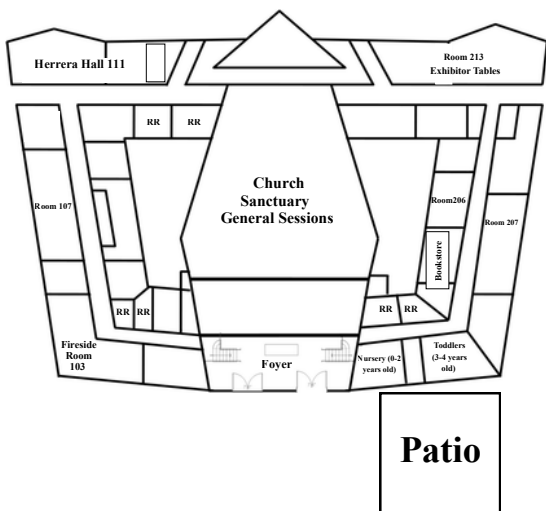

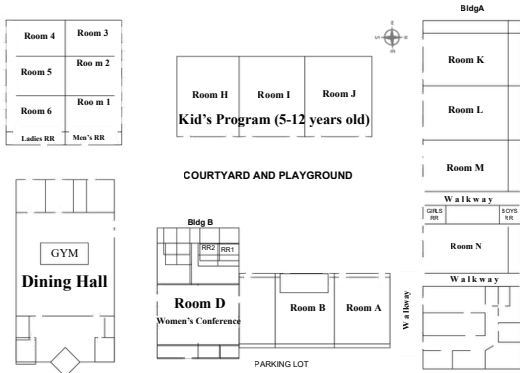

Richard is the IFCA International Executive Director. He is a graduate of Biola University (B.A.) and The Master's Seminary (M.Div.; D. Min.). Dr. Bargas served as Adjunct Professor at The Master's Seminary for 12 years and in pastoral positions for over 20 years. Richard serves on the board of Biblical Ministries Worldwide. Ryan is the founding pastor of Revolve Bible Church, where he serves following ten years in youth ministry. Alex Montoya

Alex Montoya has served as Senior Pastor of First Fundamental Bible Church in Whittier, California, since 1972. He has served as Associate Professor of Pastoral Ministries at The Master's Seminary and is a former Southern California Regional President of IFCA. The Centrifugal Church: Reclaiming Evangelism and Missionary Mandates for Genuine Evangelical Identity
