



Hello Prospective Students

Rosebud School of the Arts is excited to have you join us for a weekend of introductions, classes, and shared experiences. We sincerely hope that you will have an informative and meaningful visit. This letter outlines expectations for the weekend with a more detailed schedule provided upon your arrival.

ARRIVAL

Please see the attached schedule for the time you should arrive. Please be in touch with us if you are delayed.

Please let us know the details of your arrival. **Are you driving yourself in? Or do you need to be picked up at the Calgary airport?** Please inform us as soon as possible so we can make the necessary arrangements. An extra \$35.00 is required for your travel to and from the Calgary Airport to Rosebud.

WHAT TO BRING

- Bedding and a Pillow.
 - You will be staying either in one of the residences with other students, or at a private home. You will be given a bed in a private room, but you may need to provide your own bedding.
- Toiletries and a towel; whatever you need to spend a weekend with friends.
- Alarm Clock/Watch with an Alarm/Smart Phone
 - You will need to wake yourself up in the morning to get to class on time.
- Clothing
 - You will be going to theatre classes so bring comfortable clothes in which you feel comfortable and able to move.
 - Schedule permitting, you will be attending a show in one of our theatres, so if you would like to wear something dressier, that would be fine. Semi-casual is typical dress for Rosebud Theatre.
 - Also, if you have black or dark pants and a shirt, bring them, as you will be involved in a hospitality shift. Have something clean and neat if you don't have the above.
- Spending Money
 - If some of the other students plan to do something and you would like to join (such as a movie or coffee at the Cafe) you will need to have the means to participate. There are also some great gifts and art shops in town.

- Snacks
 - Your meals will be provided for: Breakfasts will be provided by your host each morning, and the other meals are provided by members of the community. Feel free to bring your own snacks if there are munchies you enjoy. **If you have any dietary restrictions, make sure they're included on your application form.**
- A Journal
 - To help you process your experience and record any questions you may have.

CLASS ATTENDANCE

You are expected to attend all classes and rehearsals that appear on your schedule. These are classes for our existing students. For some classes and rehearsals, you will simply be observing, for others there may be a way for you to participate if you are comfortable with that.

ETIQUETTE

You will often be staying in someone's home, so please respect their house quiet-time, and be sure to tidy up after yourself.

WORKSHOP and TALENT ASSESSMENT

At your talent assessment you will be performing for your fellow applicants and two Instructors. Our instructors are only assessing where your talents are at this time and entry into the Theatre Foundations Program is not based on how well you perform. You are expected to have your pieces memorized and ready to receive feedback. During the workshop the instructors might call upon you to use your text for exercises and work them in ways that you haven't previously rehearsed.

Please come prepared to perform **1 to 2 minutes of text**. A monologue from a play is preferred. Writing and performing your own text is not recommended. You will also be asked to **sing a song**. There will not be an accompanist or sound system, be prepared to sing a cappella or accompany yourself.

INTERVIEW

You will have at least a 45-minute (or more) interview with two members of the Rosebud School of the Arts Education Team. This is a time for you to ask any of the questions that have arisen or remain unanswered during your time in Rosebud. This is a time to find out all you need to help you make a decision about your future with Rosebud School of the Arts. It will also be a time for the Education Team to ask their questions about you. The interview is an **informal conversation** that wraps up your RSA Weekend.

The RSA Weekend is primarily a time for you to taste and see if RSA is a good fit for you and your future. Prepare yourself for a full schedule and be willing to engage. If you are a journaling sort of person, there will be time for you to do just that.
