- Design and construction of two (2) Hybrid RTG concrete runway systems;
- Design and construction of a Maintenance and Wash Facility;
- Construction of Hybrid RTG charging and parking facilities;
- Electrical power distribution and supporting infrastructure;
- Utility relocations and modifications;
- Drainage improvements;
- Asphalt restoration and site improvements;
- Site grading and pavement markings; and
- All associated civil, structural, electrical, environmental, permitting, testing, commissioning, and closeout activities necessary to place the facilities into service.

The Project will be procured using a Design-Build delivery method with award based upon Best Value. The successful Proposer shall provide all professional architectural and engineering services, permitting, construction, testing, commissioning, warranty services, closeout documentation, labor, supervision, materials, equipment, and all services necessary to complete the Project.
