The 2025 Basketball QLD (BQ) First Nations Championships is an annual celebration of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, sports, and culture, through the engagement of First Nations peoples, collaborating with other Australians to join the sporting showcase held at Coomera on the Gold Coast from Tuesday the 16th of December to Friday the 19th of December 2025.

10AM, TUESDAY 16TH DECEMBER

The Opening Ceremony will be held from 10am on the first day of the Championships. Traditional Owners will be invited to perform a Welcome to Country Ceremony. Indigenous dance groups will perform, alongside any teams that wish to do so.

3-POINT SHOOTOUT & SLAM DUNK CONTEST

A 3-Point Shootout and Slam Dunk Contest will take place again, with the date to be advised closer to the Championships.

JUNIOR 3X3 CHALLENGE

A Junior 3x3 Challenge will be played during the Champs. This is optional and open to all U12, U15 and U18 players. Players will be teamed up with players from other teams to build community and connections amongst young participants.

DEADLY BALLERS

A free Deadly Ballers session will be set up for ages 5-8. This session will include skills, drills and mini games.

COMMUNITY EXPO

Throughout the duration of the event, a designated area will be set up as the 'Community Expo'. This area will be open for service providers to set up information booths.

PRESENTATIONS & CLOSING CEREMONY

Official presentations and Closing Ceremony will take place after the final tournament game.
