As well as their ease of use, Apple devices enable employees to do more in less time through high-powered chipsets that increase processing power and enable longer battery life. **Mac users saved 45 minutes on startup/updates each month**¹. Furthermore, by integrating macOS devices into a cloud-based modern endpoint management system, organisations can ensure Mac-using employees get the same high level of support as that provided to any other technology user.

Implement solid security

Apple's architecture, encryption, OS design, updates and threat detection enhance security, reducing the risk of data breaches. macOS integrates advanced security capabilities that ensure only trusted software can be run on a Mac, as well as features such as **built-in malware defence, protection against network-based attacks and data encryption**. Using a Mac cut external attack/internal incident risk by 15 per cent and lost or stolen asset risk by 90 per cent¹.

Offering technology choice is an effective way to improve employee satisfaction. It's also a rising imperative as younger generations who have grown up with digital technology comprise more of the workforce. **Device choice shows employees their preferences are valued**, improving job satisfaction and engagement.
